

Labrador–Carrara Road (Ross Street)

Night works and detours

May 2016

From the weekend 4-5 June 2016 the roundabout at Ross Street, Currumburra Road and Ashmore Road will become a signalised intersection.

Before removing the roundabout the last of the traffic signal mast arms, posts and lanterns will be installed. Once the traffic signals become operational, the final asphalt layer and line marking will be completed through the intersection.

These works can only be done at night when traffic volumes are low. Night works will take place from Monday 30 May to Friday 24 June with lane closures and detours at times.

What to expect

- Night works will be carried out from 8pm to 6am Monday to Friday.
- Single lane closures will occur on all approaches to the roundabout during these night works.
- These works will require the use of heavy machinery and construction equipment. Noise, dust and vibration will occur.
- Light towers will be placed to limit glare to residents.
- Day works will also continue during this period, with lane closures outside of peak traffic times.
- Property and pedestrian access will be maintained for local residents at all times.

Traffic changes

Friday 3 June to Sunday 5 June

- From 8pm Friday 3 June through the weekend, the roundabout will be reduced to one lane in all directions.

Weekend 4-5 June to Friday 24 June

- From the weekend, traffic signals will be turned on and the roundabout will be a fully signalised intersection, with temporary lane configurations.
- These temporary lane configurations will remain until the final asphalt layer and line marking is installed in the coming weeks.
- **Detours** during night works will be in place for 2-3 nights between **Wednesday 8 June and Wednesday 15 June 2016** (*refer map over page*).
- During this time:
 - Ashmore Road will be closed between Warrungen Way and Willamulka Avenue
 - Currumburra Road northbound will be closed between the intersection and Milparinka Terrace
 - Currumburra Road southbound will be closed between Mulyan Place and the intersection
 - Ross Street will be open to left-in and left-out movements only

It is important to note that this work schedule depends on weather, site and contractor conditions and may change without notice.
