Night works and detours

April 2016

About the project

Asphalt works will continue on the \$30 million Labrador–Carrara Road and Ashmore Road intersection upgrade next month.

Due to high traffic volumes through the intersection, night works are required for asphalting, and for some of those nights there will be detours at the roundabout when pavement works are carried through the intersection.

What to expect

- Lane closures on all approaches to the roundabout from Sunday 8 May until Friday 20 May 2016, between 8pm and 6am
- Roundabout detours in place each night from Sunday 15 May until Friday 20 May 2016 (refer map over page)
- During this detour period:
 - Ashmore Road will be closed between Warrungen Way and Willamulka Avenue
 - Currumburra Road northbound will be closed between the roundabout and Milparinka Terrace
 - Currumburra Road southbound will be closed between Mulyan Place and the roundabout
 - Ross Street will be open to left-in and left-out movements only

It is important to note that this work schedule depends on weather, site and contractor conditions and may change without notice.

- Day works will also continue during this period, with lane closures and stop/go traffic control in place between 9am and 3pm
- Property access will be maintained for local residents with impacted residents notified of specific access arrangements prior to the detours
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- These works require the use of heavy machinery and construction equipment that will produce audible noise however the project team will minimise impacts wherever possible
- Motorists should use alternative routes when possible, or expect delays and allow additional travel time to their journey
