Apologies, Not Relevant

I approached our Principal SCO here in SA and in consultation we believe that the primary inspection should be completed by the Department of Infrastructure and Transport (DIT) Vehicle Inspectors (who are the only entity who can compete roadworthy inspections on behalf of the SA Government) to ensure the completeness of the inspection, and given the fact the vehicle would need to undergo a full inspection (called a change of ownership inspection in SA) regardless. This would then provide the necessary inspection by the issuing authority for a roadworthy certificate, an inspection by NHVR would not be deemed a roadworthy certificate here in SA.

The NHVR can assist by undertaking records of statements from the individuals when / as needed during this process to gather the evidence that Andrew will need going forward.

Evidence will need to be gathered to show that the vehicle condition has not changed since purchase etc and there may also be a requirement for a statement from the Vehicle Inspector who completes the inspection.

The current owner will need to organise this inspection locally, but it would be great to be advised when this is organised so I can contact the DIT Regency Park Inspection personnel to ensure we can get photos etc during the inspection. (This does not normally occur.)

I hope this assists Andrew going forward.

I am requiring assistance from the NHVR if they can speak with the purchaser and obtain a statement, inspect the trailers and provide a report as to the condition as the trailers are physically located in SA.

I am looking at two or three offences from the *Transport Operations* (Road Use Management – Vehicle standards and Safety) Regulation 2021 – sell vehicle without safety cert and sell defective vehicle

I have attached all the contact and info we have from the purchaser and his details, I just had to wait to get approval from the purchaser if I can sent all this info.

Hi Alana,

Just to ensure I have the right facts here.

2 Trailers came to SA and underwent a change of ownership inspection (or another type of roadworthy inspection) with DIT (Department of Transport SA).

Vehicles were deemed unroadworthy, or faults were identified.

I am assuming the complainant believed the trailers were roadworthy/fit for purpose but a subsequent inspection has shown otherwise.

Not sure what is being requested;

Do they want a statement from DIT Inspectors ( assume it was a DIT inspection) regards the initial inspection,

Do they want would a copy of the previous/initial inspection report, or

Do they want an additional inspection carried out now by NHVR and a report completed.

My view, the initial (DIT) report or a statement would be the best evidence of the trailers initial condition, any inspection performed now would have limited value as there would likely be argument as to what has happened to the trailers since.

Do you know what time frames we are talking from purchase to inspection to now?

Attached is the quote for the A trailer rego personal and B Trailer Rego personal also some videos Aswell.

As mentioned these trailers have apparently had a road worthy carried out before purchase, from all my years in this industry and dealing with transport SA i can guarantee these trailer never had roadworthy carried out and seems like they have been ticked off without a proper inspection as i know there is not one inspector regardless of what state its done in would not pass these trailers.

These trailers are very unsafe to be on the road and if they had a roadworthy carried out they would of been defected on the spot.

Due to the work that is required due to lack of Maintenace on these trailers the quotes came in very high due to all the axle and hangers needing to be replace.

As you are aware these trailer require a lot of work just to be road worthy. The list of non road worthy components are as follow.

A Trailer

All shock absorbers leaking/wern bushes.

Lots of cracks in chassis up from of trailer.

Excessive movement in all S-Cams, which has caused to wear out the spider eyes on the axles and making it not possible to fit new S-Cam tubes to axles.

All brake linings low/ on rivets and also very badly tapered due to the excessive play from the S-cams.( has also caused the eyes to wear out where the anchor pins go in)

3<sup>rd</sup> Axle R/H pivot is loose causing damage to the hanger and making it elongated.

2<sup>nd</sup> axle R/H pivot has been loose before and caused the same wear but it also has the wrong size pivot bolt fitted, which is causing the 2<sup>nd</sup> axle to move walk around.

Hangers on the 1<sup>st</sup> axle have been repaired before assuming from loose pivot bolts and has also elongated the hangers.

All pivot bushes worn.

Excessive play in all wheel bearings.

Remove one hub for inspection and found wheel bearings are worn, they have lots of pitting in cups and have lost colour indicating the cups have/are loosing there hardening, also the axle quill has a excessive lip in due to movement in wheel bearings.

Landing legs bent and also missing main cross support bar between the two legs.

#### **B** Trailer

All shock absorbers leaking/bushes worn.

All pivot bushes worn.

Excessive movement in all S-Cams, which has caused to wear out the spider eyes on the axles and making it not possible to fit new S-Cam tubes to axles.

All brake linings low/ on rivets and also very badly tapered due to the excessive play from the S-cams.( has also caused the eyes to wear out where the anchor pins go in)

Cracks in chassis at front of trailer.

Cracks in skid plate.

Skid plate is worn over legal limit.

Excessive play in all wheel bearings.

Remove one hub for inspection and found wheel bearings are worn, they have lots of pitting in cups and have lost colour indicating the cups have/are loosing there hardening, also the axle quill has a excessive lip in due to movement in wheel bearings.

Hangers on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> axle have cracks though them going right up to where the eccentrics sit in the hangers.

3<sup>rd</sup> axle L/H has cracked where bottom shock absorber bolt goes in though trailing arm.

Also noticed that these trailer been over at some stage and there is a kink in the chassis R/H/S just past the skid plate.

### Background

- On the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2022 STI Andy WILSON assigned CAS7970 to TI Chris GRACE.
- Transport and Main roads had received a ministerial complaint from personal informat on the 20<sup>th</sup> of June 2022.
- Transport Inspector Andrew SHERIDAN contacted personal information
- Transport inspector SHERIDAN'S findings are in Briefing note dated 15th of August 2022.
- Transport Inspector GRACE contacted the NHVR in South Australia on the 16<sup>th</sup> of August.
- Transport Inspector GRACE spoke with a Mr Peter THOMAS Senior Safety Compliance officer from South Australia NHVR.
- Transport Inspector GRACE received an email from Mr Jarrad MURPHY Principal Safety & Compliance Officer from the NHVR in South Australia on 21st September 2022 stating that they could no longer offer assistance to TMR.
- Transport Inspector GRACE contacted personal info to gain information about the complaint and take a statement over the phone. This was later emailed to personal info on the 4th of November.
- personal information returned the statement to the department on the 13th of November 2022.
- Transport Inspector GRACE contacted NR (Mechanic from Adelaide Heavy Vehicles) on the 21st of November 2022 to obtain a statement and information over the phone. NR said he had inspected the trailers, but this was after they had travelled from Queensland to South Australia and the trailers had been sitting some time at personal information

#### **Findings**


- The Trailers in question had been picked up from Queensland on the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2022 and driven back to South Australia arriving on the 26<sup>th</sup> of May 2022. This trip being about 2000 km.
- The trailers then got assessed by a mechanic on the 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2022. With the mechanic issuing paperwork with a list of items needing to be repaired.

#### **Outcome**

- After assessing all evidence provided to the department photographs, videos, and paperwork. No identifiers of the trailers had been taken.
- The distance travelled from Queensland to South Australia this being approximately 2000 km making the issues with the trailers that have been assets very hard to prove the defects on the trailers would have been obvious and evident at time the safety certificates issued on the trailers.
- The time the trailers had been stored at <a href="personal\_inf">personal\_inf</a> place being close to 6 weeks before being looked at by a mechanic also brings doubt into proving the issues on the trailers would have been obvious and evident at time the safety certificates issued on the trailers.

#### Recommendation

- No Further action required due to the lack of evidence.
- This complaint can be stored as information only against the AIS station if further complaints are made.



When I arrived, the trailers were parked in the street with number plates attached. The "A" Trailer had a Queensland registration plate personal attached, and the "B" trailer had a Queensland registration plate personal attached it. There was no one around at the time when I picked the trailers up, so I hooked them to my prime mover and drove back to my depot personal informal South Australia.
- 7. On the way back to South Australia I was not happy with the way the trailers towed empty, so when I arrived back in South Australia I on 26th May 2022 I contacted a mechanic I had known from the past which I trusted to book the trailers in for him to inspect. - The mechanic pers at Adelaide Heavy Vahicles also supplied me with photos and video


