

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Saturday 25 June – Friday 1 July 2011

Weekly project update

Next week, a major traffic switch will be undertaken in Goodna as Ipswich bound traffic moves onto the new permanent motorway pavement over Church Street.

Following this, the Brisbane bound lanes will be moved onto the new pavement creating access for the project team to construct the new permanent Brisbane bound lanes through this section.

New work

Goodna

Church Street underpass	Works are continuing at the Church Street underpass to install drainage and electrical conduits. The underpass will be closed between 8 pm to 5 am nightly from Sunday 26 June until Thursday 30 June 2011 . Detours and signage will be in place to safely direct motorists around works. Access for local businesses will be maintained under traffic control.
Logan Motorway off-ramp (Brisbane bound)	From 8 pm Wednesday 29 June until 5 am Thursday 30 June 2011 and 8 pm Thursday 30 June until 5 am Friday 1 July 2011 (contingency only) the Logan Motorway exit from the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane Bound) will be closed to safely install an overhead gantry. A detour will be in place via Progress Road.
Ipswich Motorway	From the night of Wednesday 29 June 2011 , traffic on the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be permanently realigned onto the new section of motorway at Goodna.

Redbank

Mine Street off-ramp	<p>The left turn lane from the Mine Street off-ramp (Brisbane bound) in Redbank will be temporarily closed from 5 am Monday 27 June until 5 am Tuesday 28 June 2011. To access the north side of Redbank, motorists need to travel through the lights at the intersection, turn left into Kerwick Street and then onto Brisbane Road.</p> <p>The straight through and right turn from the Mine Street off-ramp (Brisbane bound) will be temporarily closed from 8 pm Friday 1 July to 5 am Monday 5 July 2011. Motorists will be required to turn left at the end of the off-ramp and use the roundabout at Brisbane Road to detour back to the interchange. Detour signage will be in place.</p>

Cunningham Highway	<p>Piling works will be undertaken on the new Cunningham Highway Bridge (eastbound) in Dinmore. These works require nightly diversions for motorists taking the Brisbane Road exit from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) on the following dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monday 27 June • Tuesday 28 June • Wednesday 29 June • Thursday 30 June • Friday 1 July 2011. <p>The nightly closure of this exit will occur between 8 pm and 5 am with motorists diverted via the Cunningham Highway to the Redbank Plains interchange, then via the Cunningham Highway to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore.</p> <p>An additional closure is required from 8 pm Friday 1 July through to 5 pm Saturday 2 July. In case of weather or construction delays, nightly diversion may occur on the following dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monday 4 July • Tuesday 5 July 2011.

Church Street underpass, Goodna	One-way traffic access from Queen Street. A long-term diversion is in place via the Bertha Street underpass for traffic travelling from north to south across the motorway.	Early 2012
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	A temporary diversion is in place for pedestrians through the Goodna Train Station carpark. Repairs to the lift are currently underway.	Pedestrian footpath diversion – end July 2011 Lift operational – end June/early July 2011
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Late 2011
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road, Goodna	The old section of Smiths Road and a small part of Bellevue Road have been reduced to one-way traffic.	End July 2011
Mine Street, Redbank	The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and the Mine Street interchange will at times be reduced to one lane in each direction. Traffic may also be reduced at the Mine Street interchange while bridge works are underway.	Mine Street – End July 2011 Mine Street interchange – late 2011/early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control will be in place to direct traffic accessing Brisbane Road between Duncan and Esther Streets.	End September 2011

Endeavour Road connection, Riverview	Traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control on occasion while bridge works are underway.	Late July 2011
Dossie Lane, Dinmore	Dossie Lane is closed to traffic from both Dossie Street and Alfred Street for works on the Warrego Highway Bridge.	September 2011
Dinmore Park	<p>Pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station is being detoured around the park with temporary traffic management in place.</p> <p>Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.</p>	<p>Dinmore Park – November 2011</p> <p>Dinmore Train Station carpark – August 2011</p>

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
