

## Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Saturday 26 February–Friday 4 March 2011

Weekly Project Update

With the project now back in full swing, construction is again moving ahead quickly.

In early March, westbound traffic will be moved from its current location onto the new bridge at Mine Street, Redbank. An overhead gantry will be installed on the motorway at the same time.

This switch will require an Ipswich bound motorway closure on 7 March 2011 between the hours of 11pm and 5am.

### New work proposed

#### Redbank

Ipswich Motorway	<p>To move traffic onto the new bridge at Mine Street and to safely install an overhead gantry, traffic on the Ipswich Motorway and the Logan Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be diverted temporarily along Brisbane Road between Gailes and Goodna, onto Smiths Road and back onto the motorway at Mine Street, Redbank during the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>11.30 pm Monday 7 March to 4.30 am Tuesday 8 March 2011</b></li><li>• <b>11.30 pm Tuesday 8 March to 4.30 am Wednesday 9 March 2011 (contingency only)</b></li></ul> <p>Heavy vehicles will be directed to use the Centenary Highway. Access to properties along this detour will be maintained, however residents are asked to be patient and take care when exiting their property (see attached flyer for diversion route).</p>
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## Goodna

Brisbane Road	<p>Installation of anti-throw screens is continuing along the Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge. These night works require the temporary overnight closure of Brisbane Road (between Bertha Street and Church Street) at Goodna from <b>Sunday 27 February to Friday 4 March 2011</b>.</p> <p>A diversion will be in place via Bertha Street and Mill Street with alternative access arrangements to local businesses in place. Access out of the Queensland Rail car park (southern side) will be maintained, however access into the car park will be closed.</p>
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## Riverview

Brisbane Road	<p>Works will be undertaken from <b>Monday 28 February</b> for approximately two weeks to move the existing noise barrier closer to residents between Duncan Street and Ipswich Street. Traffic control will be in place during these works. Brisbane Road will still be maintained as a one-way street.</p>
Endeavour Road connection	<p>Construction of the retaining walls either side of the new Endeavour Road connection (Esther Street side) will begin from <b>Monday 28 February</b> for approximately six weeks. Works will involve the use of heavy vehicles fitted with reversing beepers for the safety of on-site workers.</p>

## Ongoing work

### Goodna

Goodna Train Station car park (south)	<p>Ongoing works including fencing, landscaping, electrical works and pedestrian footpaths are continuing. Access in and out of the car park is being maintained under traffic control where required.</p>
Church Street underpass	<p>Works are continuing at the Church Street underpass, with one way traffic access across the motorway at Queen Street (south to north), Goodna. Works include construction of the new overpass, retaining walls and drainage works. A long-term diversion is in place via the Bertha Street underpass for traffic travelling from north to south across the motorway. Two-way pedestrian access is being maintained at all times.</p>
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	<p>Works are continuing to complete the new pedestrian bridge, including installation of anti-throw screens, electrical works and surrounding fencing, landscaping and pedestrian footpaths. These works will mean intermittent bridge, motorway, ramp and local road closures during the night. Vehicle access will be maintained at all times under traffic control.</p> <p>Due to unexpected flood damage the new lift at the southern side of the Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge is out of service. Origin Alliance is working hard to ensure the lift is operational as soon as possible, but it may take a number of weeks before relevant parts are available due to current high demand. We thank you for your patience during this time.</p>

Brisbane Road	Works are continuing along the length of Brisbane Road from the BP service station to Hinton Street at Goodna with the construction of retaining walls for the upgrade motorway. For safety reasons, there are changed traffic conditions at the Goodna Day and Night Pharmacy to allow for increased truck movements to the project site area. Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists.
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### Redbank

Mine Street	Construction of the new Mine Street interchange is ongoing. Vehicle and pedestrian traffic on Mine Street will continue to be diverted around works. Works on Mine Street (Woodford Way to Smiths Road) are expected to be completed in early 2011.
Brisbane Road	Works are continuing on the construction of the permanent section of road from east of Six Mile Creek to Brick Street at Redbank. Works are expected to be completed by the end of March 2011.
Monash Road	Currently minor works are ongoing on the Monash Road connection. Construction activities are underway on both sides of the rail line on Monash Road and McAuliffe Street. Works are expected to occur intermittently in this area until late 2011.

### Riverview

Riverview (Tessman Street/Moggill Ferry) off-ramp closure	The Tessman Street (Moggill Ferry) off-ramp at Riverview is now permanently closed. Motorists are required to use the exits at Redbank or Dinmore to access Riverview.
Brisbane Road	A small section of Brisbane Road (near Tessman Street) is now closed to motorists to enable construction of the pedestrian bridge and southern service road (approximately 12 months). Vehicles will be detoured to Ipswich Street. Pedestrian access will be maintained, however at times may be detoured to Ipswich Street.
Endeavour Road	Major excavation and drainage works on Endeavour Road are expected to finish by Monday 28 February. Minor drainage works along Endeavour Road and McEwan Street including the installation of man holes will continue until late April 2011. Traffic control will be in place when need throughout these works.
Hansells Parade	Finishing works have commenced on Hansells Parade. As a part of these finishing works, Hansells Parade and Brisbane Road will be resurfaced and will have new kerb and guttering installed. Access to residential and business properties will be maintained though there may be some delays. Traffic control will be in place to guide motorists through the works area. These works will be ongoing until late March.

### Dinmore

Dinmore Park	Works are continuing on the new bridge in Dinmore Park. For the duration of these works, pedestrian access to the Dinmore train station will be detoured around the park with temporary traffic management in place.
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## General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to relieve traffic congestion and improve safety and reliability for motorists. The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.
