

# Start of Construction

Construction of the Ipswich Motorway Upgrade between Wacol and Darra has begun and is due for completion in late 2010.

Construction activities between March and May 2008 include:

- » relocation of public utility services, including gas, electricity, telecommunications, water and sewer
- » increased construction traffic in Sanananda Street, Kokoda Street, Wau Road and Warrender Street

- » installation of project boundary fencing and concrete barriers
- » temporary road construction for access to construction area on Centenary Highway both inbound and outbound
- » site establishment and clearing of trees and vegetation
- » progressive vegetation restoration
- » bulk earthworks along both sides of the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- » major drainage work at the Centenary Highway Interchange

In addition to these works, you may notice some changes along the Ipswich Motorway and Centenary Highway, such as increased construction vehicle movements and construction personnel around the Centenary Highway Interchange and removal and relocation of traffic signs.

During construction, every practical measure will be used to minimise any possible impact on motorists, the local community and the natural environment.

## Work Hours

Construction activities will occur between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday. Night works and weekend work may also be required and separate notifications will be provided prior to these works.
