

# Warrender Street temporary diversion

As part of the Ipswich Motorway Upgrade from Wacol to Darra, Main Roads is constructing a new bridge on the Centenary Highway over the existing Ipswich rail line.

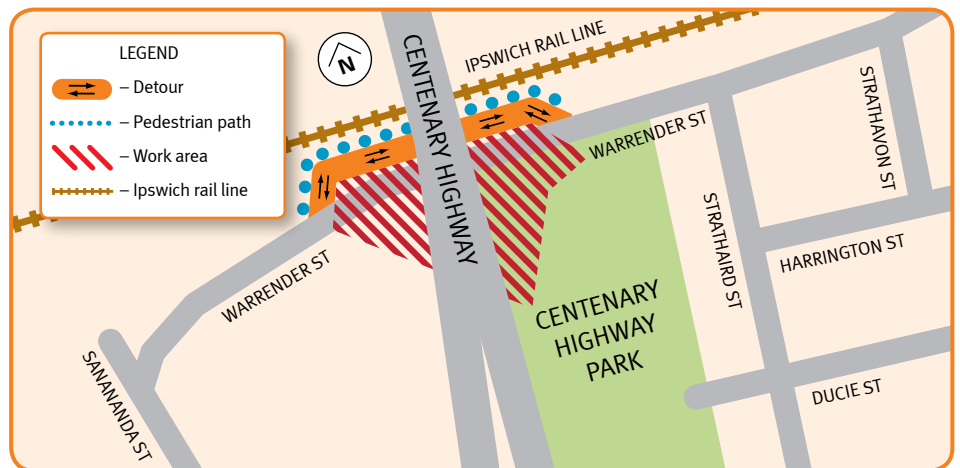
These works will include building new bridge piers and bridge deck.

From May 2008, for a period of 12 months (weather permitting), all traffic on Warrender Street under the Centenary Highway bridge will be diverted onto a temporary roadway.

Full vehicle and pedestrian access will remain at all times, however traffic management and road signage will help direct motorists and pedestrians.

Impacts will include:

- » diverting traffic travelling along Warrender Street to and from Centenary Village and Darra to a temporary roadway, and
- » increased vehicle and truck movements along Warrender Street and local roads.



## Work Hours

Traffic management will be in place during standard project work hours between 6.30am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday. If night works and weekend work are required, separate notifications will be provided prior to these works and traffic management will be in place.
