

Relocation of services - Wacol



Work to upgrade the Ipswich Motorway between Wacol and Darra is progressing with the relocation of services, west of Progress Road (Sandy Creek, Wacol to the Ipswich Logan Motorway Interchange, Gailes).

These early works will start in November 2008 and involve:

- relocating existing public utility plant services including gas, electricity, water, telecommunications and sewer pipes
- placing barriers along the Ipswich Motorway
- undertaking minor vegetation clearing works.

During these early works, you may notice some changes along the Ipswich Motorway at Wacol.

These changes will include increased vehicle movements, traffic management signs and personnel.

The Department of Main Roads is endeavouring to minimise disruptions where possible, and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrian and workers at the site.

Work is subject to weather and construction conditions with dates subject to change.

The Department of Main Roads would like to thank you for your cooperation and patience during these important works.

Please remember that safety around roadworks is a two-way street. We ask that you drive carefully and responsibly during these construction works.
