

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Permanent traffic change – access to Chalk Street, Redbank

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is upgrading the Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna and has formed Origin Alliance to deliver this project.

Around late October 2010, the existing access to the Redbank Collingwood Park Sports Complex and the Origin Alliance site offices from Chalk Street will permanently close and a new access will be opened from the signalised intersection of Smiths Road and Collingwood Drive.

At this time, the temporary roundabout on Mine Street will be removed.

This is a permanent traffic change.

The remaining section of the Smiths Road extension is expected to be completed in early 2011.

Directional signage will be in place and motorists are advised to pay attention to changed road conditions.

Please slow down – roadwork safety is your responsibility too.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
