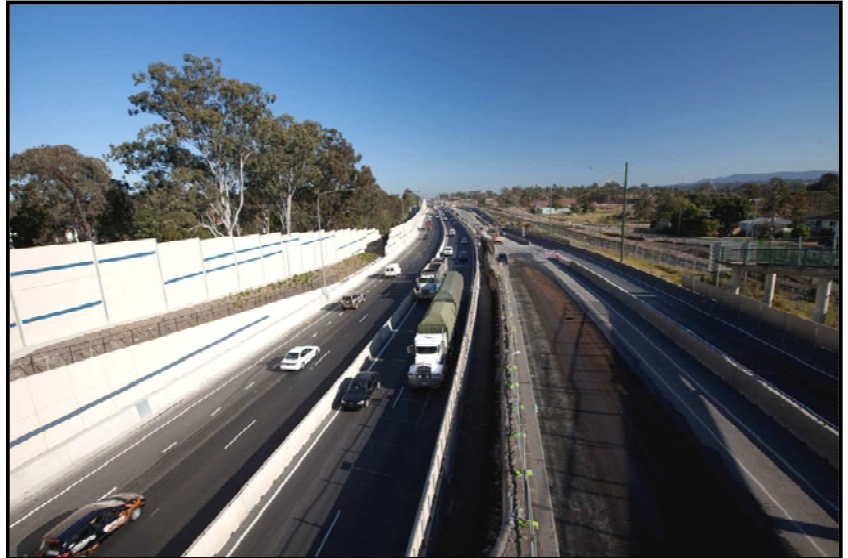

Ipswich Motorway	<p>Demolition of the existing Goodna State School pedestrian bridge will take place on the nights of 28 and 29 August 2011. A bus service will be in place to transport pupils to and from school in the morning and the afternoon until the new pedestrian bridge is open in mid September.</p> <p>The last spans of the new Goodna State School pedestrian bridge will also be lifted into place on the nights of 28 and 29 August 2011. Once the spans are in place, the decks can be poured and the anti-throw screens installed.</p>
Lower James Street	<p>Site establishment and preparation works will begin in Lower James Street in the coming weeks for the construction of an underground drain that runs from Hinton Street, under Lower James Street to the Brisbane River.</p>
Church Street	<p>Works including excavation, drainage and road re-surfacing are about to begin around the Goodna Day and Night Pharmacy in Brisbane Road, Goodna. Changed traffic conditions can be expected, traffic control will be in place to safely direct motorists and pedestrians during these works. This work will be on-going until the end of the year.</p>

Warrego Highway	<p>River Road diversions are required for westbound motorists to facilitate the installation of safety rails and asphaltting on the Warrego Highway.</p> <p>Diversions will occur at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pm Sunday 21 August to 5 am Monday 22 August • 8 pm Monday 22 August to 5 am Tuesday 23 August • 8 pm Wednesday 24 August to 5 am Thursday 25 August • 8 pm Thursday 25 August to 5 am Friday 26 August 2011.
Brisbane Road (eastbound)	Brisbane Road (eastbound) will be closed from 8 pm Monday 22 August to 5 am Tuesday 23 August 2011 . Motorists will be diverted via River Road and the Warrego Highway. Detour signage will be in place.

Church Street underpass, Goodna	One-way traffic access (south to north) from Queen Street. Northbound detour via Bertha Street.	Early 2012
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Late 2011
Woogaroo Street, Goodna	Cycle and pedestrian facilities are continuing to be constructed. Asphaltting will be undertaken along Woogaroo Street on Tuesday 23 August 2011.	Early October 2011
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road, Goodna	Finishing works are nearing completion. Traffic conditions will change from time to time. Detours and traffic control will be in place.	Late August 2011
Mine Street, Redbank	The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and north of the Mine Street interchange is currently reduced to two lanes in both directions.	Mine Street – November 2011 Mine Street interchange major works – late 2011/early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Duncan and Esther Streets.	End September 2011

Endeavour Road connection, Riverview	On occasion, traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control.	September 2011
Dossie Lane, Dinmore	Dossie Lane is closed to traffic from both Dossie Street and Alfred Street for works on the Warrego Highway.	September 2011
Dinmore Park	Pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station is currently being detoured around the park. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is currently via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park – February 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark – Late August 2011

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
