New work

Goodna

Church Street underpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	The Church Street underpass and the Brisbane bound on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway will be closed intermittently at night from Sunday 12 February until Friday 17 February 2012 . These closures are necessary to facilitate asphaltting and bridge construction works. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
Various locations	Asphaltting will be carried out between 8 pm and 5 am nightly from Monday 13 February to Friday 17 February 2012 on the following streets in Goodna: Church Street including the Church St underpass Brisbane Road from Church Street to William Street William Street William Street on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway Traffic control will be in place to direct motorists around works.



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Redbank

Brisbane bound on-ramp (Francis Street)	The Brisbane bound on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway at Redbank will be closed between 7 pm and 5 am on Friday 10 February to undertake asphaltting works. Motorists will be detoured via Brisbane Terrace. Traffic control and signage will be in place to safely direct motorists. There will be single lane closures on the motorway at Redbank for the next week for asphaltting works.
Woodford Way on-ramp (westbound)	The Woodford Way on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway (westbound) will be closed from 8 pm Friday 10 February to 5 am Monday 13 February and from 8 pm Friday 17 February to 5 am Monday 20 February 2012 for finishing works. Motorists will be detoured via the northern and southern service roads. See the attached flyer for further information.

Dinmore

Brisbane Road	Works are required on the Brisbane Road exit from the Ipswich Motorway westbound, for asphaltting and line marking. Westbound traffic on Brisbane Road will be detoured via the Warrego Highway and River Road between 8 pm and 5 am on Sunday 12 February and Monday 13 February 2012 . Traffic control will be in place for these works.
Cunningham Highway	Night works will take place between 8 pm and 5 am on Sunday 12 February and Monday 13 February 2012 for line marking and barrier movements on the Cunningham Highway. Westbound traffic will be detoured via the Warrego Highway and River Road. Traffic control will be in place for these works.

Church Street and Brisbane Road intersection, Goodna	One-way traffic access (south to north) underneath motorway. Northbound detour via Bertha Street.	Early March 2012
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Early March 2012
Lower James Street, Goodna	Construction of underground drain from Hinton Street, under Lower James Street to the Brisbane River. The Woogaroo end of Lower James Street is one-way traffic.	Mid 2012
Goodna State School pedestrian bridge	The Goodna State School pedestrian bridge is open weekdays between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm.	February 2012
Smiths Road and Stuart Street intersection	Installation of drainage, pram ramps, footpaths and kerbing. A detour is currently in place via Stephen Crescent for northbound traffic during construction hours.	Early March 2012
Mine Street, Redbank	Ongoing night works to complete Mine Street interchange. Traffic control is in place.	Late February 2012

Where	What	Completed by
Brisbane Road, Redbank	Construction of a shared cycle/pedestrian path between Bridge Street and Kerwick Street in Redbank. Traffic control will be required intermittently and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.	Late February 2012
Dinmore Park	Ongoing works for the Dinmore pedestrian bridge. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park – March 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark – March 2012

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
