

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Saturday 21 May–Friday 27 May 2011

Weekly project update

Motorists travelling towards Ipswich after Saturday night will find themselves on the new westbound bridge over Six Mile Creek.

Ipswich Motorway traffic will then be on its final alignment through this section.

Following the traffic switch, works will continue to complete the southern service road through this area.



New work

The new westbound Cunningham Highway Bridge. The old bridge is scheduled for demolition on the weekend of the 28th of May.

Goodna

Brisbane Road	As part of essential electrical works near the Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge, it is necessary to temporarily close Brisbane Road (between Bertha Street and Church Street) at Goodna from 8 pm Sunday 22 May to 2 am Monday 23 May 2011 . A diversion will be in place via Bertha Street and Mill Street with alternative access arrangements to local businesses in place.
William Street	Works will be undertaken on Monday 23 May 2011 between 8 pm and midnight on William Street, Goodna to remove existing line marking on the road. These works have to be carried out at night due to the high volume of traffic using the road during the day. New line marking will replace what is removed.
Smiths Road	Asphalt works will be undertaken on Monday 23 May 2011 between 8 pm and 2 am on Smiths Road at Goodna (near Bellevue Road). Traffic control will be in place for this work.

Redbank

Ipswich Motorway	On Saturday 21 May 2011 between 8 pm and 5 am , works will be undertaken to re-align Ipswich-bound traffic onto the new bridge at Six Mile Creek. Ipswich-bound traffic will be diverted at Mine Street and directed back onto the Woodford way on-ramp during this time.

Riverview

Old Ipswich Road	Asphalt works will be undertaken on Old Ipswich Road, near Duncan Street, on Tuesday 24 May between 8 pm and midnight . Traffic control will be in place for this work.
Hansells Parade / Alfred Street	Night works will be undertaken on Sunday 22 May 2011 between 8 pm and 5 am to build a temporary construction access over the rail lines between Alfred Street and Hansells Parade. These works will be undertaken at night due to the number of trains during the day. A contingency will be in place for the night of Monday 23 May.
Endeavour Road connection	From 7 am to 1 pm on Saturday 21 May 2011 , deck units will be erected onto the Endeavour Road connection in Riverview. Traffic control will be in place during this work.

Dinmore

Cunningham Highway	<p>Motorists will be diverted on Monday 23 May between 8 pm and midnight for approximately one hour for removal of a light pole. The diversion in place is the same as the one below.</p> <p>Demolition works will be undertaken to remove the existing Cunningham Highway Bridge (eastbound) in Dinmore from 8 pm Friday 27 May 2011 and will continue through to 5 am Monday 30 May 2011. During these works, a diversion and traffic management will be in place to safely guide motorists around works. See attached flyer for more details.</p>
Warrego Highway	Eastbound traffic on the Warrego Highway will be diverted via River Road to access the Ipswich Motorway on Monday 23 May 2011 between 1 am and 4 am in order for a light pole to be removed. Detour signage will be in place.
Dinmore Train Station carpark	Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park will temporarily change to enable construction of the new pedestrian bridge across Brisbane Road in Dinmore. This change will occur on Wednesday 25 May 2011 and will remain in place until approximately August 2011. Entry into the car park will only be via the access on Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore. See attached flyer for more details.

Ongoing work

Goodna

Church Street underpass	Works are continuing at the Church Street underpass, with one-way traffic access from Queen Street. A long-term diversion is in place via the Bertha Street underpass for traffic travelling from north to south across the motorway.

Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	<p>Works are continuing to complete the new pedestrian bridge. The existing footpath along a section of Brisbane Road near the lift, has temporarily closed with pedestrian access diverted through the Queensland Rail car park. This diversion will be in place for approximately two months. Access to the pedestrian bridge will be maintained.</p> <p>Origin Alliance is working hard to ensure the lift is operational as soon as possible, but due to current high demand for the relevant parts, the lift is not expected to be operational until late June 2011.</p>
Brisbane Road	Works are continuing along the length of Brisbane Road from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp with the construction of retaining walls for the motorway upgrade. Works will be ongoing until late 2011.
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road	Finishing works on Smiths Road and Bellevue Road are continuing and will be complete by June 2011.

Redbank

Mine Street	The section of Mine Street between Collingwood Drive and the interchange is expected to be completed in July 2011. Major works on the Mine Street interchange will be ongoing until late 2011.
Monash Road	Works are continuing on the Monash Road connection and will occur intermittently in this area until late 2011.

Riverview

Brisbane Road	Construction is underway on the section of service road between Tessman Street and Esther Street. Works will continue until approximately August 2011.

Dinmore

Dossie Lane	Earthworks have commenced along Dossie Lane in preparation for the construction of the new retaining wall and eastbound lanes of the Warrego Highway. To enable these works, Dossie Lane has been closed to traffic and Dossie Street is now a cul-de-sac at the end that joins Dossie Lane. This arrangement will be in place until approximately September 2011.
Dinmore Park	Works are continuing on the new bridge in Dinmore Park. For the duration of these works, pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station will be detoured around the park with temporary traffic management in place. These works will continue until approximately November 2011.



General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to relieve traffic congestion and improve safety and reliability for motorists. The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
