New work

Goodna

William Street on-ramp	The William Street on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway at Goodna will be closed from 8 pm until 4.30 am nightly between Sunday 20 November and Thursday 24 November 2011 . This closure is necessary to facilitate painting of the retaining walls. A diversion will be in place along Smiths Road, Goodna to direct Ipswich bound motorists to the Mine Street on-ramp at Redbank.
Brisbane Road	Brisbane Road between Bertha and Church Streets will be closed nightly between 8 pm and 4.30 am from Monday 21 November until Thursday 24 November 2011 for electrical works on the retaining walls. A detour will be in place along Mill Street. Access to and from the Queensland Rail car park will be maintained under traffic control.
Church Street underpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	The Church Street underpass and the Brisbane bound on-ramp at Goodna will be closed each night between 8 pm and 4.30 am from Sunday 20 November until Thursday 24 November 2011 . This closure is necessary to undertake bridge works. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.

Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound)	In preparation of a traffic switch on the Ipswich Motorway, near the Mine Street bridges, Brisbane bound traffic will be diverted at the Mine Street off-ramp and along Francis Street to re-enter the motorway between 8 pm and 5 am on Sunday 20 November 2011 .
Brisbane Road (Bridge Street to Brisbane bound on-ramp)	Access to the Brisbane bound on-ramp at Redbank from Brisbane Road will be closed on Monday 21 November 2011 between 8 pm and 5 am due to asphaltting and traffic light installation works. A detour will be in place via Mine Street and Francis Street.
Ipswich Motorway	Night works will be undertaken over the next fortnight to install large motorway signage frames near the Shell service station at Redbank. Installation works will be undertaken between 8 pm and 5 am on Thursday 17 November, Friday 18 November, Monday 21 November, Tuesday 22 November, Wednesday 23 November, Sunday 27 November, Monday 28 November and Tuesday 29 November (contingency only) . There will be slow lane closures in both Brisbane bound and Ipswich bound lanes during these times, as well as brief traffic stops. Traffic control will be in place during the works.

Dinmore

Brisbane Road	<p>Brisbane Road westbound will be closed between 8 pm and 5 am on Thursday 24 November and Friday 25 November 2011 to facilitate asphalt works.</p> <p>Traffic from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be diverted via the Cunningham Highway to the Redbank Plains interchange, then via the Cunningham Highway to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore. In case of weather or construction delays, works may occur on the night of Wednesday 16 November 2011.</p> <p>Night works are required to install a conduit across Brisbane Road (west of Aberdare Street) in Dinmore. Works will be undertaken between 8 pm and 5 am on Tuesday 22 November, Wednesday 23 November and Thursday 24 November 2011. Traffic control will be in place to guide motorists around works.</p>
Cunningham Highway	Works are continuing on upgrading the Cunningham Highway and Aberdare Street connection to the southern service road. Earthworks and asphalt works will be undertaken between 8 pm and 5am from Sunday 20 November to Thursday 24 November 2011 .
Warrego Highway	Night works will be undertaken to remove the last section of the old Warrego Highway Bridge in Riverview. For the safety of motorists and onsite workers, the Warrego Highway east and westbound traffic will be diverted via River Road, Dinmore from 8 pm Saturday 19 November to 5 am Sunday 20 November 2011 . In case of weather or construction delays, a diversion may occur from 8 pm Sunday 20 November to 5 am Monday 21 November 2011 .

Goodna State School pedestrian bridge	The new Goodna State School pedestrian bridge is now open each weekday between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm. Access is via temporary stairs at the bridge site in Woogaroo Street.	Late 2011
Barram Street and Albert Street, Goodna	Construction of cycle/pedestrian path.	Late 2011 / early 2012
Smiths Road and Stuart Street intersection	Installation of drainage.	Early December 2011
Pan Pacific Peace Gardens, Redbank	Access via Francis Street, Railway Terrace and McAuliffe Street.	Mid December 2011
Francis Street, Redbank	Changed traffic conditions to access properties on Francis Street and Kerwick Street.	Early December 2011
Mine Street, Redbank	Works to complete Mine Street between Smiths Road and the interchange. Night works are ongoing around the interchange. Construction of the interchange at the Mine Street underpass.	Mine Street – Late November 2011 Mine Street interchange – early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Tessman Street and Six Mile Creek.	Late November 2011

Brisbane Road, Dinmore	Ongoing night works to upgrade the Brisbane Road/Aberdare Street intersection.	Late November 2011

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.
