## New work

### Goodna

Church Street underpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	The Church Street underpass and the Brisbane bound on-ramp at Goodna will be closed between <b>8 pm and 4.30 am from Sunday 18 December to Wednesday 21 December 2011</b> . This closure is necessary to undertake bridge construction works. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
Brisbane Road	Brisbane Road between Bertha Street and Church Street at Goodna will be closed between <b>8 pm and 4.30 am from Sunday 18 December to Thursday 22 December 2011</b> to facilitate painting of the pedestrian bridge. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
Ipswich Motorway	Night works will be undertaken in early January 2012 to install an overhead motorway gantry at Goodna. Installation works will be undertaken between <b>8 pm and 5 am from Wednesday 4 January until Sunday 8 January 2012</b> . There will be slow lane closures in both Brisbane bound and Ipswich bound lanes of the motorway during these times and a section of Brisbane Road will be closed to facilitate the installation. Detours and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists during the works.

## Redbank

Mine Street	Mine Street will be temporarily closed between Francis Street and Brisbane Road from <b>3 January 2012</b> for three weeks to enable the final pavement to be constructed. Access to Mine Street will be maintained for residents and visitors via Brisbane Road. Traffic detours, signage and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists around the works using the new Francis Street alignment. Pedestrian access along Mine Street will be maintained at all times. See the attached flyer for more information.
Brisbane Road	Works will be undertaken from <b>3 January 2012</b> for approximately six weeks to install a shared pedestrian and cycle path between Brick Street and Kerwick Street in Redbank. Traffic control will be required intermittently and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

## Dinmore

Warrego Highway	Night works are required to install permanent barriers and asphalt along the Warrego Highway in Riverview. Traffic from the Warrego Highway westbound will be detoured via River Road between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Wednesday 4 January and Thursday 5 January 2012</b> . Detour signage will be in place for these works.

Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	January 2012
Lower James Street, Goodna	Construction of underground drain from Hinton Street, under Lower James Street to the Brisbane River. The Woogaroo end of Lower James Street is one-way traffic.	Mid 2012
Goodna State School pedestrian bridge	The Goodna State School pedestrian bridge is open weekdays between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm.	February 2012
Barram Street and Albert Street, Goodna	Construction of cycle/pedestrian path.	Late 2011 / early 2012
Smiths Road and Stuart Street intersection	Installation of drainage, pram ramps and kerbing.	Early 2012
Mine Street, Redbank	Construction of the interchange at the Mine Street underpass.	Early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Endeavour Road and Six Mile Creek.	Late January 2012

### General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.
