## New work

### Goodna

Goodna off-ramp (eastbound)	From Monday morning <b>6 February 2012</b> , motorists will be driving along the new permanent Brisbane bound alignment of the Ipswich Motorway. The Goodna off-ramp (eastbound) will reopen at this time.
Church Street underpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	The Church Street underpass and the Brisbane bound on-ramp at Goodna will be closed from <b>6 am Saturday 4 February until 4.30 am Monday 6 February 2012</b> . This closure is necessary to undertake bridge construction works. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
Brisbane Road	Brisbane Road between Church Street and William Street will be closed on <b>Tuesday 7 February 2012 from 7.30 pm to 5 am</b> to facilitate asphaltting. On <b>Wednesday 8 February 2012</b> , Brisbane Road near the Queensland Rail car park will be closed from <b>7.30 pm to 5 am</b> and around the Goodna Day and Night pharmacy from <b>9 pm to 5 am</b> to facilitate asphaltting works. A detour will be in place via Mill Street.
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	The Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge will be closed until <b>Monday 6 February 2012</b> to facilitate concrete works. Origin Alliance will continue to run a shuttle bus to transport passengers to and from the Goodna Train Station with pick up from the station on the northern side and the QR carpark on the southern side. The bus will run continuously from <b>6.30 am to 6.30 pm Monday to Friday</b> and from <b>9 am to 3 pm Saturday and Sunday</b> . Alternatively, pedestrians can access the train station via the Church Street or Bertha Street underpass. For assistance with access, please call 1800 465 682.

## Redbank

Brisbane bound on-ramp (Francis Street)	The Brisbane bound on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway (eastbound) at Redbank will be closed <b>between 7 pm and 5 am</b> to facilitate asphaltting works on <b>Monday 6 February, Tuesday 7 February and Thursday 9 February 2012</b> . Motorists will be detoured via Brisbane Terrace. Traffic control and signage will be in place to safely direct motorists around the works.
Woodford Way on-ramp (westbound)	The Woodford Way on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway (westbound) will be closed from <b>8 pm Friday 10 February to 5 am Monday 13 February 2012</b> for finishing works. Motorists will be detoured via the northern and southern service roads. See the attached flyer for further information.

## Riverview

Southern service road	The southern service road, between Law Street South at Redbank and Aberdare Street at Dinmore, will be open in its entirety to motorists, cyclists and pedestrians from the afternoon of <b>Saturday 4 February 2012</b> . A community day has been planned to celebrate this opening. See the flyer attached for further details.

## Dinmore

Warrego Highway	Night works are required for asphaltting, linemarking and barrier movements along the Warrego Highway in Dinmore. Traffic from the Warrego Highway westbound will be detoured via River Road between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Tuesday 7 February 2012</b> . Detour signage will be in place for these works.
Brisbane Road	Works are required on Brisbane Road, east of the Aberdare Street intersection, for asphaltting and line marking. Eastbound traffic on Brisbane Road will be detoured via River Road between <b>8 pm and 5 am from Sunday 5 February to Thursday 9 February 2012</b> . Traffic control will be in place for these works.
Cunningham Highway	Night works will take place between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Wednesday 8 February and Thursday 9 February 2012</b> for line marking and barrier movements on the Cunningham Highway. Eastbound traffic will be detoured via the Aberdare Street off-ramp and River Road. Traffic control will be in place for these works.
Aberdare Street off-ramp	The Aberdare Street off-ramp from the Cunningham Highway eastbound will be closed to traffic between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Friday 3 February 2012</b> for asphalt works. Traffic will be detoured to the Mine Street off-ramp at Redbank and back onto the motorway via Woodford Way. Detour signage will be in place.

Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Early March 2012
Lower James Street, Goodna	Construction of underground drain from Hinton Street, under Lower James Street to the Brisbane River. The Woogaroo end of Lower James Street is one-way traffic.	Mid 2012
Goodna State School pedestrian bridge	The Goodna State School pedestrian bridge is open weekdays between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm.	February 2012
Smiths Road and Stuart Street intersection	Installation of drainage, pram ramps, footpaths and kerbing. A detour is currently in place via Stephen Crescent for northbound traffic during construction hours.	Mid February 2012
Mine Street, Redbank	Ongoing night works to complete Mine Street interchange. Traffic control is in place.	Mid February 2012
Brisbane Road, Redbank	Construction of a shared cycle/pedestrian path between Bridge Street and Kerwick Street in Redbank. Traffic control will be required intermittently and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.	Late February 2012
Dinmore Park	Ongoing works for the Dinmore pedestrian bridge. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park – March 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark – March 2012

### General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

### All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
