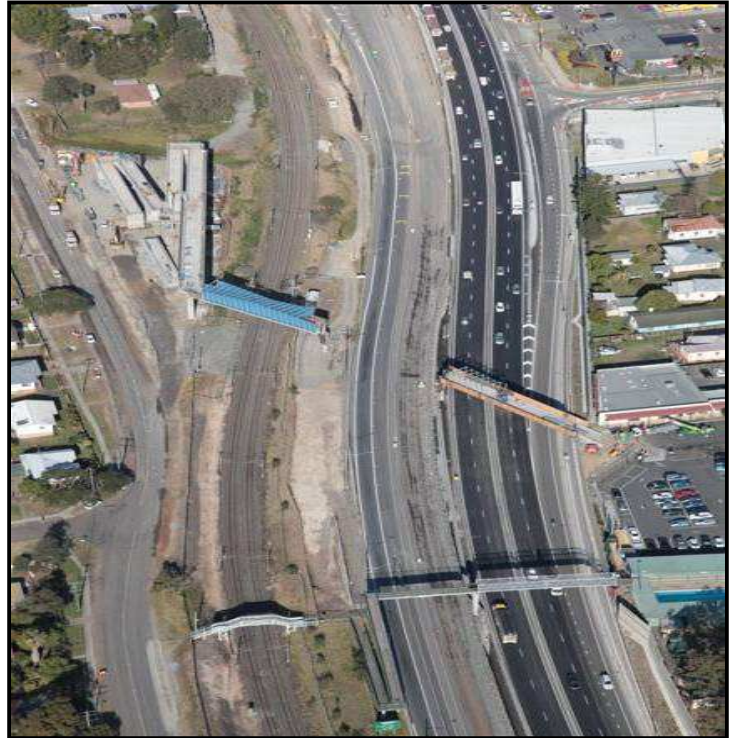
Weekly project update

Changes will be in place for motorists who use the Goodna off-ramp from the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane-bound) from Sunday 31 July 2011.

The off-ramp will close for approximately six months, while important works are underway to construct the new Brisbane-bound motorway lanes through Goodna.

Motorists travelling from the west who wish to access Goodna will need to use either the Mine Street exit at Redbank and detour via Smiths Road or the Logan Motorway exit at Gailles and detour via Brisbane Road. Detour signage will be in place.

New work

Redbank

Mine Street (south side of motorway)	Works will be undertaken between 8 pm and 5 am each night from Sunday 31 July to Thursday 4 August 2011 to install conduits on the northern side of the Mine Street interchange. Traffic control will be in place during this work.
Collingwood Drive (between Namatjira and Smiths Road intersections)	Works will be undertaken from 8 pm on Friday 29 July to 5 am Monday 1 August 2011 to complete the pavement between Namatjira Drive and Smiths Road. Motorists heading towards the Ipswich Motorway will be reduced to one lane during these works under traffic control.
Brisbane Road/Bridge Street roundabout	From 7 pm Sunday 31 July to 4 am Monday 1 August 2011 , asphaltting works will occur on the Brisbane Road/Bridge Street roundabout in Redbank.
Mine Street underpass	The Mine Street underpass will be closed from 7 pm Saturday 6 August to 5 am Sunday 7 August and from 7 pm Sunday 7 August to 5 am Monday 8 August 2011 to facilitate the installation of bridge deck beams. Motorists will be detoured via Smiths Road and Brisbane Terrace. See the attached flyer for more information.

Warrego Highway	<p>Asphalt works will be undertaken at night on the new Warrego Highway Bridges. For the safety of motorists and onsite workers, these works require diversions via River Road, Dinmore. Motorists travelling along the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) to the Warrego Highway (westbound) will be diverted at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 8 pm Monday 1 August to 5 am Tuesday 2 August 2011 - 8 pm Tuesday 2 August to 5 am Wednesday 3 August 2011. <p>Motorists travelling along the Warrego Highway (eastbound) to the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) will be diverted at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 8 pm Thursday 4 August to 5 am Friday 5 August 2011 - 8 pm Sunday 7 August to 5 am Monday 8 August 2011.

Where	What	Completed by
Church Street underpass, Goodna	Demolition is continuing on the old Church Street bridge. One-way traffic access (south to north) from Queen Street. Northbound detour via Bertha Street.	Early 2012
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	A temporary diversion is in place for pedestrians through the Goodna Train Station carpark. Repairs to the lift are almost complete.	Pedestrian footpath diversion – late July 2011 Lift operational – late July 2011
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Late 2011
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road, Goodna	Finishing works are nearing completion. Traffic conditions will change from time to time. Detours and traffic control will be in place.	Mid August 2011
Mine Street, Redbank	The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and north of the Mine Street interchange will at times be reduced to one lane in each direction.	Mine Street – Mid August 2011 Mine Street interchange major works – late 2011/early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Duncan and Esther Streets.	End September 2011
Endeavour Road connection, Riverview	On occasion, traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control.	September 2011
Dossie Lane, Dinmore	Dossie Lane is closed to traffic from both Dossie Street and Alfred Street for works on the Warrego Highway.	September 2011
Dinmore Park	Pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station is currently being detoured around the park. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is currently via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park – February 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark – Late August 2011

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
