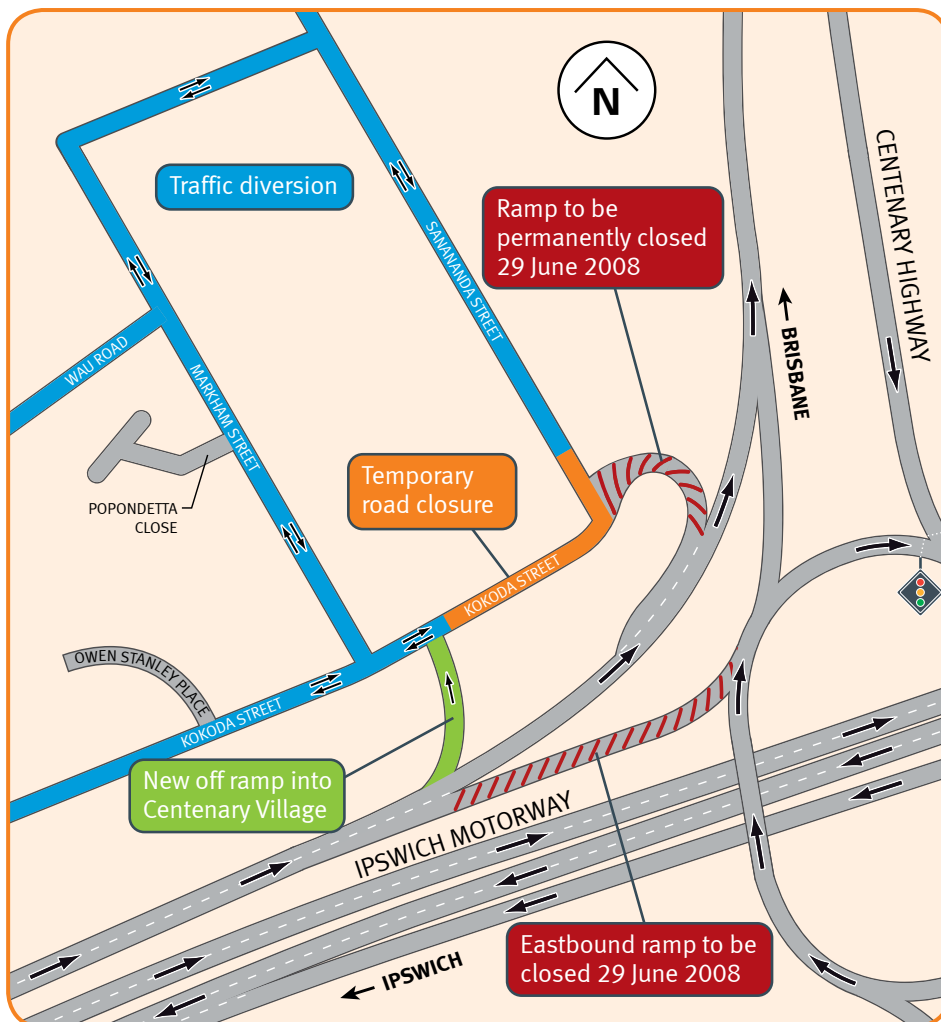


Opening of new Centenary Village off-ramp

As part of the Ipswich Motorway Upgrade from Wacol to Darra, Main Roads is constructing a new off-ramp to provide access for motorists entering into Centenary Village.

To allow for the construction of the new Centenary Highway Interchange all traffic entering Centenary Village via the Centenary Highway northbound off-ramp will be diverted onto a new roadway from **10.00pm, Sunday 29 June 2008**.

These works will include the temporary closure of the south east corner of Kokoda and Sanananda Streets for a period of eight weeks from 29 June 2008. This will allow for the construction of a new road alignment for motorists travelling north on the Centenary Highway.
