

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Saturday 4–Friday 10 June 2011

Weekly project update

The project would like to thank motorists for their patience while works are underway to complete the permanent section of Mine Street, between Collingwood Drive and the Ipswich Motorway.

The northbound lanes will continue to be reduced to one lane between 9 am and 3 pm to allow a safe working zone for machinery and crews.

New work

Goodna

Bellevue Road and Smiths Road	Works will be undertaken on Tuesday 7 June, Wednesday 8 June and Thursday 9 June 2011 (contingency only) between 7 pm and 5 am to lay asphalt on Smiths Road and Bellevue Roads, Goodna. Traffic control will be in place during this work.
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Redbank

Mine Street off-ramp	The left turn lane from the Mine Street off-ramp (Brisbane bound) in Redbank will be closed temporarily from 5 am Monday 6 June 2011 for approximately seven days (and nights) . To access the north side of Redbank, motorists will need to travel through the lights at the intersection, turn left into Kerwick Street and then onto Brisbane Road (refer to attached flyer). Night works will also be undertaken as part of this work between 8 pm and 5 am each night from Monday 6 June to Saturday 11 June 2011.
Mine Street interchange	Works will be undertaken on Saturday 4 June 2011 between 7 am and 5 pm to remove the median strip on Mine Street under the Ipswich Motorway. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction under traffic control during this work.



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Riverview

Ipswich Motorway	Works will be undertaken from Sunday 5 June 2011 for five nights between 8 pm and 5 am to construct a pier for the new Tessman Street pedestrian bridge in Riverview. Traffic on the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be reduced to one lane during these works.
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Dinmore

Warrego Highway	<p>Night works will be undertaken to lift bridge beams onto the new Warrego Highway Bridge (Brisbane bound) in Dinmore. For the safety of motorists and onsite workers, these works require diversions via River Road, Dinmore. Motorists travelling from the Warrego Highway to the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) will be diverted at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 8 pm Friday 3 June to 5 am Saturday 4 June 2011• 8 pm Saturday 4 June to 9 am Sunday 5 June 2011. <p>In case of wet weather or construction delays, a diversion may occur from 8 pm Sunday 5 June to 5 am Monday 6 June 2011.</p>
Cunningham Highway	<p>Night works are required to safely relocate concrete barriers and asphalt of along the Cunningham Highway west of Aberdare Street. Motorists travelling from the Ipswich Motorway to the Cunningham Highway (westbound) will be diverted via Brisbane Road and Aberdare Street at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 8 pm Sunday 5 June to 5 am Monday 6 June 2011• 8 pm Thursday 8 June to 5 am Friday 9 June 2011.

Ongoing work

Goodna

Church Street underpass	Works are continuing at the Church Street underpass, with one-way traffic access from Queen Street. A long-term diversion is in place via the Bertha Street underpass for traffic travelling from north to south across the motorway.
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	The temporary closure of the pedestrian footpath will be in place until the end of July. Origin Alliance is working hard to ensure the lift is operational as soon as possible, but due to current high demand for the relevant parts, the lift is not expected to be operational until late June 2011.
Brisbane Road	Works are continuing along the length of Brisbane Road from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp with the construction of retaining walls for the motorway upgrade. Works will be ongoing until late 2011.
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road	Finishing works on Smiths Road and Bellevue Road are continuing and will be complete by the end of June 2011.



Redbank

Mine Street	<p>The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and the Mine Street interchange is expected to be completed in July 2011. At times, traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction along Mine Street and delays are expected.</p> <p>Major works on the Mine Street interchange will be ongoing until late 2011.</p>
Monash Road	<p>Works are continuing on the Monash Road connection and will occur intermittently in this area until late 2011.</p>

Riverview

Brisbane Road	<p>Construction is underway on the section of service road between Tessman Street and Esther Street. Works will continue until approximately August 2011. Pedestrian access between Brisbane Road and Tessman Street will continue to be closed during the day for approximately one more week. Pedestrians are required to use Ipswich Street and Nile Street to access Tessman Street.</p>
Endeavour Road connection	<p>Works are ongoing to complete the new bridge over the Endeavour Road connection in Riverview. To enable these works, traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control. This arrangement will remain in place until approximately July 2011.</p>

Dinmore

Dossie Lane	<p>Earthworks have commenced along Dossie Lane in preparation for the construction of the new retaining wall and eastbound lanes of the Warrego Highway. To enable these works, Dossie Lane has been closed to traffic and Dossie Street is now a cul-de-sac at the end that joins Dossie Lane. This arrangement will be in place until approximately September 2011.</p>
Dinmore Park	<p>Works are continuing on the new bridge in Dinmore Park. For the duration of these works, pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station will be detoured around the park with temporary traffic management in place. These works will continue until approximately November 2011.</p> <p>Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park has temporarily changed to enable construction of the new pedestrian bridge across Brisbane Road in Dinmore. Entry into the car park will only be via the access on Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore. This change will remain in place until approximately August 2011.</p>



General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to relieve traffic congestion and improve safety and reliability for motorists. The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
