

# Major traffic change

The Department of Transport and Main Roads is upgrading the Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna and has formed Origin Alliance to deliver this project.

Origin Alliance will upgrade the existing motorway to six lanes, improving safety, easing congestion, providing improved access to public transport and enhancing cycle and pedestrian facilities.

### Redbank access from the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) will change permanently

From **Monday 1 March 2010**, Origin Alliance will permanently close the Brisbane Road off-ramp from the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound).

Motorists heading eastbound to Redbank who use the Brisbane Road exit will be required to use the Mine Street off-ramp from the motorway. Detour signage will be in place to direct traffic.

This permanent closure of the Brisbane Road off-ramp (Brisbane bound) will allow works to commence on the northern service road connecting Dinmore to Redbank. These works form part of the overall Ipswich Motorway Upgrade aimed at reducing congestion, improving safety and providing motorists with more reliable travel times.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
