

# Safety improvements

## from April to June 2012

Works such as improvements to traffic signal phasing and increases to turning lane storage capacity will take place at various intersections on Brisbane Road.

What to expect:

- Working hours
  - Day works will be from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday (and Saturday if required) with lane closures from 9am to 3pm.
  - Night works will be from mid-April to end June from 7pm to 5am for electrical works.
- There will be single lane closures and reduced speed limits during construction.
- Motorists are advised to follow the directions of traffic controllers and roadside signs during these works.
- This schedule may change without notice due to wet weather or site conditions.

### Intersection of Computer Street

- Right-turn movements from the Gold Coast Highway into Computer Street will be changed so that right-turning traffic is fully controlled by a red, yellow and green turn arrow.

### Intersection of Pine Ridge Road and Captain Cook Drive

- The U-turn facility, east of the Pine Ridge Road intersection, will be closed.
- The westbound right-turn lane will be extended to allow safer U-turn movements at the Pine Ridge Road traffic signals.

### Intersection of Cabarita Street and Babbidge Street

- Right-turn movements from the Gold Coast Highway into Cabarita Street will be changed so that right-turning traffic is fully controlled by a red, yellow and green turn arrow.
- Extension of the eastbound right-turn lane.
