Church Street and Brisbane Road intersection, Goodna	One-way traffic access (south to north) underneath motorway. Northbound detour via Bertha Street.  Changed traffic conditions in front of Goodna Day and Night Pharmacy.	Early 2012  Late 2011
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Late 2011

Woogaroo Street, Goodna	Cycle and pedestrian facilities construction.	Early October 2011
Lower James Street, Goodna	Construction of underground drain from Hinton Street, under Lower James Street to the Brisbane River. The Woogaroo end of Lower James Street is one-way traffic.	Mid 2012
Goodna State School pedestrian bridge	The new Goodna State School pedestrian bridge is now open each weekday between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm. Access is via temporary stairs at the bridge site in Woogaroo Street.	Late September 2011
Stanley Street, Goodna	Construction of cycle/pedestrian path.	
Mine Street, Redbank	The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and north of the Mine Street interchange will at times be reduced to one lane in each direction.	Mine Street – November 2011 Mine Street interchange major works – late 2011/early 2012
Francis Street, Redbank	Changed traffic conditions to access properties on Francis Street and Kerwick Street.	Early December 2011
Brisbane Road, Redbank (between Mine Street and Brick Street)	Construction of on-road cycle lanes.	Mid October 2011
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Duncan and Esther Streets.	Early October 2011
Endeavour Road connection, Riverview	On occasion, traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control.	Late September 2011
McEwan Street / Station Road, Riverview	Construction of on-road cycle lanes and new intersection.	Mid October 2011
Brisbane Road, Dinmore	Ongoing night works to upgrade the Brisbane Road/Aberdare Street intersection. Westbound Brisbane Road closure (exit from Ipswich Motorway) in place at night from Sunday 25 September to Thursday 29 September.	Late October 2011
Dossie Lane, Dinmore	Dossie Lane is closed to traffic from both Dossie Street and Alfred Street for works on the Warrego Highway.	Late September 2011
Dinmore Park	Pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station is currently being detoured around the park. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park – February 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark – Late September 2011

## General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

### All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
