

## Overpasses

Overpasses will feature in the MMTC planning and provide the Sunshine Coast community with improved connectivity.

A pedestrian and cycle overpass is a bridge, elevated road or similar structure that allows pedestrians and cyclists to safely cross a major road or rail corridor.

To meet Australian health and safety standards, a fully enclosed screen would be installed on the overpass to prevent objects falling onto the road.



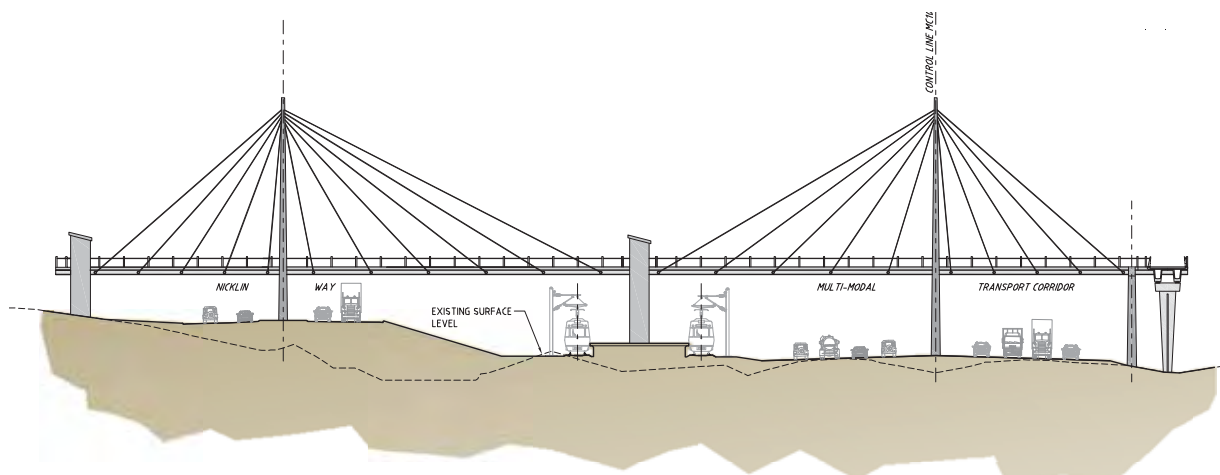
## Overpass benefits

There are benefits of building an overpass. These include:

- safe access through the use of ramps and/or lifts for people with disabilities, parents or carers with prams, and people using mobility scooters
- people can access facilities in neighbouring areas conveniently
- pedestrians and cyclists can get out and be active easily thereby contributing positively to sustainability and climate change outcomes.
