Sunshine Coast Multi-Modal Transport Corridor

What is the MMTC?

Project overview

As the Sunshine Coast grows, it is essential that transport systems and infrastructure are developed to meet the region's needs.

The MMTC is a transport corridor from Caloundra Road to the Sunshine Motorway. It will contain a motorway-standard road (Caloundra-Mooloolaba Road), local arterial road, integrated pedestrian and cycle facilities and from Creekside Boulevard north, the CAMCOS rail line.

Project consultants SKM and PB have been engaged to assist Main Roads with the MMTC planning.

Main Roads is working closely with State and Local Government agencies and planners of other Sunshine Coast projects to ensure the overall needs for transport on the Sunshine Coast are considered.

Work to date

Construction is already underway on the first stage of the southern section of Caloundra-Mooloolaba Road between Caloundra Road (near Corbould Park) and Creekside Boulevard. This part of the road will open to traffic in 2009.

At the Sunshine Motorway, the planning builds upon previous studies and extends north to Maroochy Boulevard and west to the Kawana Way Interchange.

Planning will confirm the ultimate preferred pedestrian, cycle, road and public transport system within the corridor. The project will then assess and confirm details for future stages and recommended timing for construction.
