

# Pacific Motorway Upgrade Project, Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill

The Pacific Motorway Upgrade from Springwood (south) and Daisy Hill is the first priority stage to upgrade the Pacific Motorway between the Gateway and Logan motorways.

## Southbound motorway works at Old Chatswood Road

Construction of an additional southbound motorway lane between Aranda Street and the Old Chatswood Road off-ramp (Exit 23) is continuing, with completion expected by late 2012, weather permitting.

Temporary night closures of the southbound Old Chatswood Road on and off-ramps are continuing from Sundays to Thursdays between 8pm and 5am during June and July 2012. Service relocation and drainage installation works are being carried out during this time. Detour signage will be in place to guide motorists.

## Major weekend works – Old Chatswood Road on and off-ramps August 2012

Major reconstruction works are planned at the southbound Old Chatswood Road on and off-ramps from 8pm Friday 3 August to 5am Monday 6 August 2012, weather permitting.

During these continuous works, the Old Chatswood Road on and off-ramps will be closed to traffic. Closing the on and off-ramps will allow for works to excavate the ramp surfaces, place several asphalt layers and reinstate traffic signs and line markings.

Detours will be provided around the work site as shown in the map below, with traffic controllers and police to direct traffic as needed. Local access for businesses will be maintained. Some traffic delays can be expected.

Local residents and business will be notified before works start. Thank you for your patience during these important works.

## Final asphaltting works at the Loganlea Road interchange

Asphaltting works are due to be completed at the Loganlea Road on and off-ramps, Loganlea Road and the western service road in June.

Permanent signage is scheduled to be installed and line markings finished in mid-June 2012, weather permitting.

## Works at Winnetts Road, Village Drive and John Paul Drive

Construction activities on these local roads are being finalised, with completion expected by late June 2012, weather permitting.

Residents can expect some night works along John Paul Drive in June 2012 while asphaltting works are finished. Noisier activities will be completed before midnight, where possible, with some temporary lane closures planned. Traffic controllers and detour signage will be in place to direct motorists.

## Slacks Creek park 'n' ride construction

Major construction works are scheduled to start in June 2012 at the new Slacks Creek park 'n' ride, located on the corner of Nujooloo and Loganlea Roads. Local residents will be notified of any expected disruptions associated with works.

Completion of the new park 'n' ride is scheduled for late 2012, weather permitting. Further information about the park 'n' ride is available on Translink's website at [www.translink.com.au/project](http://www.translink.com.au/project).

## Works along the motorway

New noise barriers are being installed within the project zone. Residents directly affected by these activities will continue to be notified of any expected disruptions.

Motorway asphaltting works to improve the road surface are continuing at night between Sundays and Thursdays. Some noise, lane closures/realignments and minor traffic delays can be expected. Weather permitting, works on the northbound motorway are scheduled for completion in mid-2012, with southbound motorway works expected to be completed in October 2012.

Works in the centre median and motorway shoulders to install new guard rails, concrete barriers and drainage are also continuing. For safety reasons, some night works are required to complete these activities.

Works on the new bikeway, located adjacent to the motorway between Nujooloo Road and Elonera Drive, are expected to be completed in July 2012.

## Final works at the Paradise Road on-ramp

Temporary night closures of the northbound Paradise Road on-ramp are currently planned for mid-July 2012 to complete the final layers of asphalt on the upgraded ramp. The temporary closures will occur between 8pm and 5am, with detour signage in place to safely guide motorists. Traffic will be detoured via Loganlea Road.

Final line markings on the on-ramp are scheduled for completion in mid-2012, weather permitting.

## Safety and access

Please take care when travelling around roadworks. Traffic changes will be signposted, with traffic controllers in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as required. Detours for pedestrian and cycle paths are also in place where required.
