

## Pacific Motorway Upgrade Project, Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill

**The Pacific Motorway Upgrade from Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill is the first priority stage to upgrade the Pacific Motorway between the Gateway and Logan motorways.**

### Final works at Winnetts Road and Nujooloo Road

Construction activities on most of the local roads are close to completion, with final asphaltting and line marking works currently scheduled for April 2012, weather permitting. Works will be carried out at night to reduce traffic disruptions, with noisier activities completed before midnight, where possible. Local residents will be notified prior to works starting.

### Works at Winnetts Road, Village Drive and John Paul Drive

Construction of a cul-de-sac at the northern end of Winnetts Road connecting to Village Drive is scheduled for completion in May 2012, weather permitting

Once earthworks, drainage installation and noise barrier construction are completed at John Paul Drive in May 2012 (weather permitting), works to install the final layer of asphalt in this area will start. Works will be carried out at night to reduce traffic disruptions, with noisier activities completed before midnight, where possible. Local residents will be notified prior to works starting.

### Slacks Creek park 'n' ride construction

Early works are continuing in preparation for major works to start on the new Slacks Creek park 'n' ride on the corner of Nujooloo and Loganlea Roads.

Activities scheduled for April/May 2012 include earthworks, drainage installation and construction of concrete retaining walls adjacent to the park 'n' ride facility on the western side of Nujooloo Road.

Completion of the new park 'n' ride is scheduled for late 2012, weather permitting.

## Southbound motorway works at Old Chatswood Road

Construction of an additional southbound motorway lane between Aranda Street and the Old Chatswood Road off-ramp (Exit 23) is continuing, with completion expected by late 2012, weather permitting. The existing southbound Old Chatswood Road on and off-ramps will be reconstructed as part of these works.

Temporary night time closures of the southbound Old Chatswood Road on and off-ramps are currently scheduled for late May 2012 to allow service relocation works to be completed safely. The temporary closures are expected to occur between 8pm and 5am, with detour signage in place to safely guide motorists. Local residents and businesses will be notified prior to works commencing. Traffic will be detoured via Loganlea Road.

For the safety of motorists and road workers, the speed limit on the eastern service road will be reduced at times to 40 km/h and the motorway speed limit will remain posted at 80 km/h until completion of project works.

## Works along the motorway

Drainage and retaining wall construction is underway near the Paradise Road on-ramp.

Construction of new retaining walls alongside the motorway near the old Shailer Road and Nujooloo Road on and off-ramps is continuing.

Works in the median are being progressively completed and barriers removed from the centre of the motorway.

Motorway asphaltting works to improve the road surface are continuing at night between Sundays and Thursdays, with completion expected in mid-2012, weather permitting. Some noise, lane closures/realignments and minor traffic delays can be expected.

## Safety and access

Please take care when travelling around roadwork. Traffic changes will be signposted, with traffic controllers in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as required. Detours for pedestrian and cycle paths are also in place where required.

**Please slow down - Roadwork safety is your responsibility too.**
