

# Welcome to the May 2011 construction update

The \$420 million Pacific Motorway Upgrade Project from Springwood (south) and Daisy Hill is the first stage of the Pacific Motorway upgrade between the Gateway and Logan motorways.

## Loganlea Road / Nujooloo Road intersection – temporary closure

Nujooloo Road will be reconstructed in late June, 2011, weather permitting, between the Loganlea Road/Nujooloo Road intersection and 25 Nujooloo Road.

This section of Nujooloo Road will be closed for a full weekend between Saturday night and Sunday night.

Continuous works will take place during the closure to allow activities to be completed safely and in less time, minimising disruption to local residents and motorists.

## Winnetts Road – temporary realignment

Winnetts Road has been temporarily realigned between Vine Street and Dahlia Street to allow for the southbound Winnetts Road on and off-ramps, and adjoining intersection to be completed. These works will continue for approximately five months.

Access to Vine Street from Winnetts Road will be left-in only and there will be no access to Winnetts Road from Vine Street during construction of this intersection.

The speed limit along Winnetts Road will remain reduced to 40km/h with traffic controllers in place to ensure trucks and pedestrians can enter and exit the work site safely.

## Western Service Road – bridge works and traffic detour

Construction of the first stage of the Western Service Road bridge over the new northbound Loganlea Road on-ramp is underway.

On the Western Service Road a temporary traffic detour and reduced speed limit of 50km/h remain in place to allow drainage and earthworks to be completed safely.

## On the Pacific Motorway – road surface work

Upgrading of the road surface on the motorway will resume later this month. Short-term lane closures and traffic delays can be expected.

For the safety of roadworkers and motorists, these asphaltting works are being scheduled to occur at night between Sundays and Thursdays.

Earthworks, drainage and asphaltting works are continuing near Springfield Crescent to widen the southbound lanes of the motorway.

## Safety and access

Please take extra care when travelling through the work zone, expect frequent on-road changes, and give yourself time to read the roadside signs placed to assist you.

Traffic changes and detours will be signposted, with traffic controllers in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as required.

Pedestrian and cycle detour paths are also being provided where needed.

**Please slow down – roadworks safety is your responsibility too.**

## Permanent motorway ramp closures

Standards for safe operation of motorway on and off-ramps have increased in recent years, requiring more distance between ramps to reduce the potential for traffic weaving and accidents.

## Nujooloo Road on and off-ramps

The northbound Nujooloo Road on and off-ramps will close permanently in mid-2011. Motorists can use the northbound Loganlea Road on and off-ramps at this time.

## Shailer Road on and off-ramps

The existing southbound Shailer Road on-ramp will close permanently in mid-late 2011, when the new southbound Winnetts Road on-ramp is completed.

The existing southbound Shailer Road off-ramp will also close permanently in mid-late 2011. As an interim arrangement, motorists will use either the existing Bryants or Winnetts Road off-ramps, until the new southbound Winnetts Road off-ramp opens to traffic in late 2011.

## Northbound Exit 23 to Paradise Road

The northbound off-ramp Exit 23 to Paradise Road will close permanently in late 2011. Traffic will then use the upgraded northbound Exit 24 for access to Loganlea Road, the Western Service Road and Paradise Road.
