

## Major weekend works — 8 to 11 July 2011 (weather permitting)

Construction works are continuing on the \$420 million Pacific Motorway Upgrade project from Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill, with major works planned from 8 pm Friday 8 July to 5 am Monday 11 July 2011, weather permitting.

These works will allow the new Loganlea Road overpass bridge to be opened to traffic with one lane operating in each direction. Intersections on both sides of the new bridge will be realigned, and the new Loganlea Road/Nujooloo Road intersection will be completed. The old Loganlea Road overpass bridge will be closed permanently for demolition.

Continuous construction activities involving placement and compaction of a large volume of rock and asphalt, and frequent truck movements around the work site can be expected for the weekend.

### What to expect during works:

- temporary closure of the northbound Loganlea Road on and off-ramps
- temporary lane closures along Loganlea Road
- temporary closure of Nujooloo Road, adjacent to the Loganlea Road/Nujooloo Road intersection
- permanent closure of the old Loganlea Road overpass bridge from Friday night
- opening of the new Loganlea Road overpass bridge (one lane operating in each direction until the old bridge is demolished and new intersections completed).

### Night works

Intermittent night works will be required throughout July 2011 around Nujooloo Road, Loganlea Road, Winnetts Road, and on the motorway. Some noise and light from the worksite can be expected.



Detours will be provided around the work site, with traffic controllers and police in place at critical intersections to ensure safe traffic movements. Local access for residents and businesses will be maintained. Some traffic delays can be expected.

## Winnetts Road temporary access changes

From Monday 11 July for one week, weather permitting, Winnetts Road, north of the new Loganlea Road bridge, will be closed to northbound traffic. Motorists travelling from Loganlea Road to access John Paul Drive are advised to turn right onto Winnetts Road, left into Daisy Hill Road, left into Chatswood Road and left into John Paul Drive.

From Monday 11 July for two weeks, weather permitting, access to Vine Street from Winnetts Road will be temporarily unavailable. Motorists can detour via Dahlia Street, Veronica Avenue and Boronia Avenue.

Please be aware the speed limit along Winnetts Road within the work site is reduced to 40km/h and traffic controllers are in place to ensure trucks and pedestrians can enter and exit the work site safely.

## Removing the old Loganlea Road overpass bridge

Demolition of the old Loganlea Road overpass bridge is expected to start in late July 2011, continuing for approximately two weeks, weather permitting. To complete works safely, the majority of activities will be undertaken at night with some temporary partial closures of the motorway both north and southbound. Detours will be provided on local roads where required. Nearby residents may experience noise disruptions during bridge demolition works.

## Western Service Road bridge works and detour

Construction is continuing on the new Western Service Road bridge over the Loganlea Road on-ramp. Stage one of works to connect the bridge to the local road network will be completed as part of the major weekend works in early July 2011.

A temporary traffic detour and reduced speed limit of 50km/h remains in place along the Western Service Road to allow drainage works and earthworks to be completed safely.

## Permanent motorway ramp closures

Standards for safe operation of motorway on and off-ramps have increased in recent years, requiring more distance between ramps to reduce the potential for traffic weaving and accidents.

### Nujooloo Road on and off-ramps

The northbound Nujooloo Road on and off-ramps will close permanently in mid-2011. Motorists can use the northbound Loganlea Road on and off-ramps at this time.

### Shailer Road on and off-ramps

The existing southbound Shailer Road on-ramp will close permanently in mid-late 2011, when the new southbound Winnetts Road on-ramp is completed.

The existing southbound Shailer Road off-ramp will also close permanently in mid-late 2011. As an interim arrangement, motorists will use either the existing Bryants or Winnetts Road off-ramps, until the new southbound Winnetts Road off-ramp opens to traffic in late 2011.

### Northbound Exit 23 to Paradise Road

The northbound off-ramp Exit 23 to Paradise Road will close permanently in late 2011. Traffic will then use the upgraded northbound Exit 24 for access to Loganlea Road, the Western Service Road and Paradise Road.

## Safety and access

Please take extra care when travelling through the work zone, expect frequent on-road changes, and give yourself time to read the roadside signs placed to assist you.

Traffic changes and detours will be signposted, with traffic controllers in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as required.

Pedestrian and cycle detour paths are also being provided where needed.
