

# Pacific Motorway Upgrade Project

## Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill

Welcome to the October 2010 construction update. The \$422 million Pacific Motorway Upgrade Project is the first priority stage of an upgrade of the Pacific Motorway from the Gateway to Logan Motorway.

Project works include rehabilitating the motorway from Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill, a major upgrade of the Loganlea Road interchange, constructing a bus park 'n' ride, improvements to the Paradise Road roundabout, and a new section of bikeway. Completion is expected in late 2011, weather permitting.



### 'Team M1' supporting local industry

Supporting the State Government's Local Industry Policy, the Pacific Motorway Upgrade Project, Springwood (south) to Daisy Hill, is creating work opportunities for local people.

The project team, known as 'Team M1' by its participants, is a collaboration between the Department of Transport and Main Roads and contractor group, the BHA Joint Venture. This joint venture involves three locally-owned and operated construction companies, Beilby Holdings, JF Hull Holdings and Albem.

Team M1 has grown rapidly over the past year, and currently provides construction-related jobs for more than 130 people, and work opportunities for hundreds of additional subcontractors and suppliers. This includes ongoing support for a range of Logan City businesses.

In its first year 'in the field', Team M1 recorded more than 160,000 working hours on site. The team will more than double this figure before the end of the project in late 2011.

## Current works and traffic changes

Preparations are now underway for the placement of the first deck units of the new Loganlea Road overpass bridge.

### Pacific Motorway

Bridge foundation works are continuing in the central median of the Pacific Motorway for the new Loganlea Road overpass bridge.

In the coming weeks, deck units for the overpass bridge will be placed, requiring temporary night time traffic changes in the southbound lanes of the motorway for works to be completed safely. Temporary diversions will be signposted, and traffic controllers will direct motorists around the works.

Works to widen the southbound lanes of the motorway near Springfield Crescent are also continuing. These daytime activities involve earthworks, drainage installation, pavement works and asphaltting. Temporary construction vehicle entry and exit points have been established at Springfield Crescent and Winnetts Road. Project water carts and street sweepers are routinely servicing earthwork areas and haul roads as part of the project's dust control measures.

Night works are ongoing along the motorway to repair and strengthen the road surface, and lay new asphalt. Some noise, vibration, short-term lane closures and traffic delays can be expected during these works.

### Loganlea Road / Nujooloo Road area

A recent project milestone was opening the temporary detour around the existing Loganlea Road / Nujooloo Road intersection to traffic, and commencing work on the new intersection. Initial activities include earthworks, drainage and installation of services.

Piling works for the new northbound Loganlea Road motorway on-ramp are commencing. These day works may result in some localised noise and vibration. Once complete, the grade separated on-ramp will allow northbound traffic to travel beneath the Western Service Road to access the Pacific Motorway.

Works on the new Loganlea Road northbound motorway off-ramp and bikeway underpass are also progressing well. Construction of the off-ramp embankment and drainage will continue this month.

### Safety and access

Please take care when travelling around the roadworks. Speed limits may be reduced in some areas. All traffic changes will be signposted and traffic controllers will be in place to direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as required. Detour paths around roadworks will also be provided for pedestrians and cyclists as required.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents and motorists, and we thank you for your patience and cooperation during these important works.

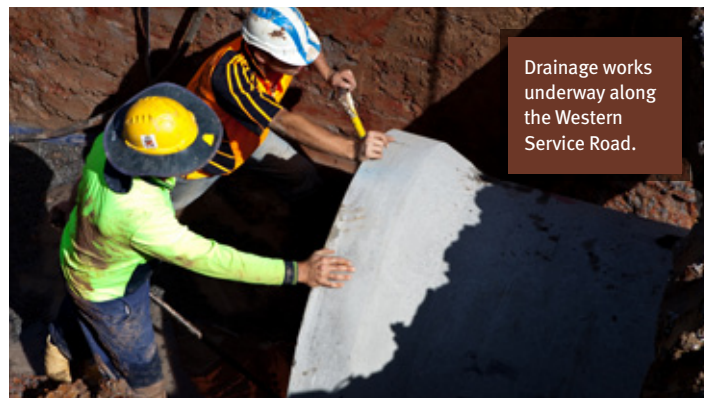

### Winnetts Road area

The project team is also working on the new southbound motorway on and off-ramps at Winnetts Road. Embankments are now in place, and installation of drainage and retaining structures is underway. Some noise, vibration and night works may be expected.

In the Winnetts Road area near the work site, speed limits have been reduced to 40km/h and some short-term lane closures may be required during the day to complete works safely. Trucks will continue to access the site from Winnetts Road.

### Western Service Road area



Drainage works underway along the Western Service Road.

Construction of a temporary detour at the Western Service Road / Loganlea Road intersection is commencing. As part of these works, the existing Loganlea Road northbound motorway on-ramp is being temporarily realigned. Some night works and short-term lane closures may be expected to complete works safely. Once the detour is completed, construction of the Western Service Road bridge and retaining walls will begin.

For local commuters, please be aware that existing bus stops on either side of the Western Service Road have been temporarily relocated a short distance north, towards Paradise Road.
