

# Mackay/Whitsunday Region

Queensland's 33,000km transport network and infrastructure has received more damage than any other state government asset during recent flooding and cyclone events. The Department of Transport and Main Roads is now focused on the massive task of returning the damaged transport network to pre-disaster condition.

As part of the largest construction program in the state's history, the department will undertake over 250km of roadworks in the Mackay/Whitsunday region over the next few years. This will restore a safe and efficient transport network to current engineering standards.

The department is delivering the program under the joint federal and state government funded Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA) guidelines.
