

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade - Wacol to Darra

Construction Update No 2

June – August 2008

The Queensland Government has appointed SAFELink Alliance to design and construct the Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Wacol to Darra.

Construction of the upgrade began in March 2008 with expected completion in late 2010.

Construction activities between June and August 2008 include:

- continued relocation of public utility services, including gas, electricity, telecommunications, water and sewer
- bulk earthworks along both sides of the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway and within the Centenary Highway Interchange
- major drainage work at the Centenary Highway Interchange
- road pavement construction along the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- construction of bridges along the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- construction of large retaining walls along the Centenary Highway and within the Centenary Highway Interchange
- commencement of a new service road to the north of the Ipswich Motorway

During construction, every practical measure will be used to minimise impacts on motorists, the local community and the natural environment.
