

Project update – Goodna



Construction on the Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna has passed the half way point, with works now going full steam ahead in the Goodna area.

Works around the Church Street underpass are continuing. Piling for the new Church Street bridge began in late August 2011 with the retaining walls around the bridge being constructed throughout September and October 2011. The Brisbane bound bridge spans will be lifted into place in November 2011.

Works are continuing around the Brisbane bound on and off-ramps at Goodna, with the off-ramp re-opening by the beginning of 2012.

Pavement work and the construction of retaining walls around the Goodna Day and Night Pharmacy will continue throughout September and October 2011.

The Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge lift is now operational and the footpath and landscaping are complete.

Works on the Brisbane bound alignment of the motorway are continuing with on-going excavation and construction to align with the Ipswich bound lanes of the motorway.

Goodna State School pedestrian bridge under construction

At the end of August, the last spans of the new Goodna State School pedestrian bridge were lifted into place and the existing pedestrian bridge was demolished. Works are continuing on the new pedestrian bridge, the anti-throw screens and lighting will be installed over the next few months. The bridge opened during the day only in mid September.

Preparatory works have begun on the noise barrier along the southern side of Woogaroo Street, between Lower Albert and Lower James Streets, with construction due to begin in late September.

Works on the Goodna section of the cycleway are almost finished along Woogaroo Street, works are continuing on the Brisbane Terrace section and will continue until mid 2012. Works include the construction of on-road cycle lanes, shared concrete paths, a pedestrian and cycle bridge over Woogaroo Creek at Brisbane Terrace and resurfacing of roads.



Project update – Goodna

Origin Alliance is working with Ipswich City Council to install an underground drainage pipe that will start at the end of Hinton Street and run under the motorway and Lower James Street to meet with the Brisbane River. A tunnel boring machine will be used to dig the tunnel for the drainage pipe. Site establishment and preparatory works began in late August and construction started mid September. The culvert should be completed by mid 2012

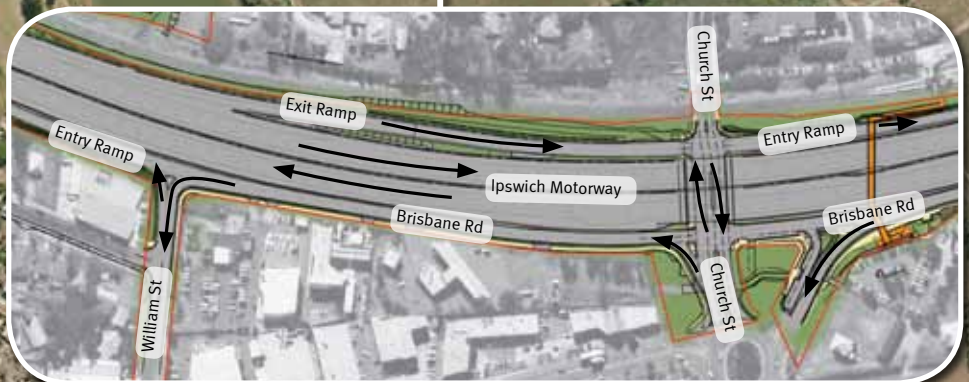
