

# Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Saturday 7 January 2012 – Friday 13 January 2012

## New work

### Goodna

Church Street underpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	The Church Street underpass and the Brisbane bound on-ramp at Goodna will be closed between <b>8 pm and 4.30 am from Sunday 8 January to Thursday 12 January 2012</b> . This closure is necessary to undertake bridge construction works. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
Brisbane Road	Brisbane Road between Bertha Street and Church Street at Goodna will be closed between <b>8 pm and 4.30 am from Monday 9 January to Thursday 12 January 2012</b> to facilitate painting of the pedestrian bridge. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
Ipswich Motorway	Night works will be undertaken to install an overhead motorway gantry at Goodna. Installation works will be undertaken between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Saturday 8 January and Sunday 9 January 2012 (contingency only)</b> . There will be slow lane closures in both Brisbane bound and Ipswich bound lanes of the motorway during these times and a section of Brisbane Road will be closed to facilitate the installation. Detours and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists during the works.



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## Dinmore

Brisbane Road (westbound)	<p>The Brisbane Road exit from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be closed nightly between <b>8 pm and 5 am from Tuesday 10 January to Friday 13 January 2012</b> to facilitate bridge works. Traffic from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be diverted via the Cunningham Highway to the Redbank Plains Road and Cunningham Highway interchange, then travel Brisbane-bound on the Cunningham Highway back to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore.</p> <p>This exit will also close from <b>4 am Saturday 14 January through to 5 am Monday 16 January 2012</b> for the installation of lighting under the bridges. Motorists are asked to drive carefully and follow diversion signage in place.</p>
Cunningham Highway	<p>Night works will be undertaken to complete landscaping, guard rail and concrete works along the Cunningham Highway in Dinmore. These works will occur between <b>8 pm and 5 am from Sunday 8 January to Thursday 12 January 2012</b>. Motorists travelling to Brisbane will be diverted via the Aberdare Street off-ramp to the Brisbane Road on-ramp onto the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound).</p>
River Road	<p>Night works are required to asphalt a section along the Warrego Highway, Riverview and to relocate barriers along Brisbane Road, Dinmore. Works will be undertaken nightly from <b>Monday 9 January to Friday 13 January 2012 between 8 pm and 5 am</b> and require diversions via River Road, Dinmore.</p> <p>In the coming weeks, a series of diversions via River Road, Dinmore will be required to facilitate the laying of the final layers of asphalt in the Dinmore section of the project. Dates for these works will be posted in the weekly project update.</p>

Church Street and Brisbane Road intersection, Goodna	One-way traffic access (south to north) underneath motorway. North bound detour via Bertha Street.	Early 2012
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna Ipswich bound on-ramp.	February 2012
Lower James Street, Goodna	Construction of underground drain from Hinton Street, under Lower James Street to the Brisbane River. Lower James Street is currently one-way.	Mid 2012
Goodna State School pedestrian bridge	The Goodna State School pedestrian bridge is open weekdays between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm.	February 2012
Albert Street, Goodna	Construction of cycle/pedestrian path.	Early 2012



Smiths Road and Stuart Street intersection, Goodna	Installation of drainage, pram ramps and kerbing.	Early 2012
Mine Street, Redbank	Works at the Mine Street interchange.	Early 2012
Mine Street, Redbank	Mine Street closed between Francis Street and Brisbane Road from <b>3 January 2012</b> for three weeks to enable the final pavement to be constructed. Works will be from 6 am to 6.30 pm Monday to Saturday. Access to Mine Street will be maintained for residents and visitors via Brisbane Road. Traffic detours, signage and traffic control are in place to direct motorists onto the new Francis Street alignment. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.	Late January 2012
Brisbane Road, Redbank	Works started on <b>3 January 2012</b> for approximately six weeks to install a shared pedestrian and cycle path between Bridge Street and Kerwick Street in Redbank. Traffic control will be required intermittently and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.	Late February 2012
Brisbane Road, Dinmore	On-going night works to upgrade the Brisbane Road and Aberdare Street intersection.	Late January 2012
Dinmore Park	On-going works for the Dinmore pedestrian bridge. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park: February 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark: February 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Endeavour Road and Six Mile Creek.	Late January 2012

### General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists.

The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the



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Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.
