Weekly project update

Major traffic change:

From Sunday morning 10 July 2011, motorists heading towards Ipswich, Warwick or Toowoomba will need to be aware of changes to these exits from the Ipswich Motorway.

Motorists heading west towards the Warrego Highway or Ipswich (Brisbane Road) will need to stay in the left lane. Motorists heading towards the Cunningham Highway will need to stay in the right lane.

Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound)	<p>The Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) exit to the Logan Motorway will be temporarily closed during the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 8 pm Saturday 16 July to 5 am Sunday 17 July 2011• 8 pm Sunday 17 July to 5 am Monday 18 July 2011 (contingency only). <p>The closure is necessary to safely install light poles. A detour will be in place via Progress Road.</p>
Church Street underpass	<p>The old Church Street bridge will be demolished on the nights of 14 and 15 July 2011. Traffic control will be in place to safely direct and detour traffic during these works.</p>

Redbank

Mine Street (between Namatjira Drive and the Ipswich Motorway interchange)	<p>Works will be undertaken on Mine Street, between Namatjira Drive and the Ipswich Motorway, from 7 pm Friday 8 July 2011 to 4.30 am Monday 11 July 2011. Works (including night works) will be noisy at times and involve profiling, excavation, asphaltting, linemarking and barrier movements.</p> <p>Traffic will operate with two lanes open for traffic heading towards Collingwood Park and one lane for traffic heading towards the motorway between the lights at Namatjira Drive and the Woodford Way on-ramp.</p>

Upcoming diversions along River Road, Dinmore	<p>Over the next week, night works will be undertaken on the Warrego Highway Bridges; and to implement two major traffic switches along the Ipswich Motorway. Church Street underpass, Goodna	One-way traffic access (north to south) from Queen Street. Detour via Bertha Street.	Early 2012
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	A temporary diversion is in place for pedestrians through the Goodna Train Station carpark. Repairs to the lift are almost complete.	Pedestrian footpath diversion – end July 2011 Lift operational – late July 2011
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Late 2011
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road, Goodna	Works are underway on reinstating driveways to 13 properties, with part road closures in Smiths Road.	Mid July 2011
Mine Street, Redbank	The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and north of the Mine Street interchange will at times be reduced to one lane in each direction. Traffic may also be reduced at the Mine Street interchange while bridge works are underway.	Mine Street – End July 2011 Mine Street interchange – late 2011/early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct traffic accessing Brisbane Road between Duncan and Esther Streets.	End September 2011
Endeavour Road connection, Riverview	Traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control on occasion while bridge works are underway.	Late July 2011

Dossie Lane, Dinmore	Dossie Lane is closed to traffic from both Dossie Street and Alfred Street for works on the Warrego Highway Bridge.	September 2011
Dinmore Park	<p>Pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station is currently being detoured around the park.</p> <p>Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is currently via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.</p>	<p>Dinmore Park – November 2011</p> <p>Dinmore Train Station carpark – Late August 2011</p>

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
