

CLASS PERMIT No. 127-TH-12

Controlled Access Buses

(Not exceeding 14.5m overall length)

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995

This permit is issued under the provisions of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management—Mass, Dimensions and Loading) Regulation 2005*, Part 6, Division 2 – Permits, and is a means of alternative compliance with the provisions of the Part 3, section 24 and 29 of the Regulation.

This permit applies to buses with an overall length greater than 12.5 metres but not greater than 14.5 meters.

Permit period:

This permit is valid for the period **1 July 2012 to 30 June 2015** (inclusive) unless sooner revoked by the chief executive of the Department of Transport and Main Roads or his delegate.

Pursuant to section 51(1) of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management—Mass, Dimensions and Loading) Regulation 2005*, it is hereby approved to drive the vehicles mentioned herein on a road, subject to the following conditions:

- 1 Vehicles covered by this permit **may operate** on the following routes:
 - All routes as shown in the map *The State Road Network of Queensland at 30 June 2007*.
 - Routes as detailed in Schedule "A" Part 1 *Additional approved routes for controlled access buses*.
 - Routes as detailed in Schedule "A" Part 2 *Brisbane City Council Additional approved routes for controlled access buses*.
- 2 Vehicles covered by this permit **may not operate** on routes as shown in the maps in Schedule "B" *State controlled roads not suitable for Controlled Access Buses*.
- 3 Rear overhang of the bus not to exceed the lesser of 4.7 metres or 70% of the distance between the centre of the front axle and the rear overhang line.
- 4 This permit may be utilised as proof that the controlled access bus mentioned herein is acceptable for registration. This permit does not apply to mobile homes.
- 5 A copy of this permit **must** be carried by the driver at all times when operating under this permit and produced when requested by an authorised officer. When operating on roads detailed in Schedule "A" Part 1 or Part 2 a copy of the appropriate sections of the schedule **must** be carried with this permit.
- 6 The Department of Transport and Main Roads reserves the right to amend or withdraw this permit as policy is further developed.
- 7 The holder of this permit shall indemnify the Department of Transport and Main Roads and its employees, against any claim, action or process for damage or injury that may be sustained against them due to the use of vehicles as specified.
