

CLASS PERMIT No. 129-TH-12

Car Carriers

Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995

This permit is issued under the provisions of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management—Mass, Dimensions and Loading) Regulation 2005*, Part 6, Division 2 – Permits, and is a means of alternative compliance with the provisions of Part 3, Division 2 – Particular dimensions, sections 24 Length – motor vehicles and 26 Height.

This permit applies to single trailer car carrier combinations constructed to a length of 19 metres and/or 4.6 metres high.

Permit period:

This permit is valid for the period **1 July 2012 to 30 June 2015** unless sooner revoked by the chief executive of the Department of Transport and Main Roads or his delegate.

This permit is subject to the provisions of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995* and all Regulations from time to time made thereunder and to the terms and conditions below:

- 1 The following maximum dimensions apply when operating under this permit:
 - Combination not to exceed 21.4 metres in length and 4.6 metres in height when loaded with vehicles.
 - Front and rear projections not to exceed 1.2 metres.
 - Rear overhang not to exceed 4.9 metres when loaded with vehicles.
- 2 The lower deck must be fully loaded before vehicles are placed on the upper deck.
- 3 Vehicles operating under this permit must comply with the following route/operating conditions:
 - 3.1 Vehicles operating under this permit **may operate** on all roads in Queensland with sufficient clearance for the car carrier combination to pass without striking or damaging any overhead structures, including cables.
 - 3.2 Vehicles **may not operate** on roads signed to restrict the operation of the car carrier combinations.
- 4 All car carrier combinations must have current registration.
- 5 All units in the combination must have current certificates of inspection, where required.
- 6 A copy of this permit must be carried at all times when operating under the conditions of the permit and produced to an authorised officer when requested.
- 7 The Department of Transport and Main Roads reserves the right to amend or withdraw this permit as policy is further developed.
- 8 The holder of this permit shall indemnify the Department of Transport and Main Roads and its employees, against any claim, action or process for damage or injury that may be sustained against them due to the use of vehicles as specified.
