

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna

Saturday 28 May–Friday 3 June 2011

Weekly project update

This weekend signals the demolition of the old Cunningham Highway Bridge in Dinmore. Last weekend, Brisbane bound traffic was switched onto the new bridge enabling the project team to move forward with the demolition.

New work

Goodna

William Street on-ramp to Ipswich Motorway	<p>On Saturday 28 May 2011 from 5.30 am until 10.30 am, work will be undertaken on the Goodna State School pedestrian bridge. Concrete will be pumped from concrete trucks parked next to the bridge at the cul-de-sac end of Albert Street to form the bridge walkway.</p> <p>There may be brief delays on the Ipswich bound on-ramp to the motorway at William Street during the concrete pour.</p>
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Redbank

Mine Street interchange	<p>Night works will be undertaken on Sunday 29 and Monday 30 May 2011 between 8 pm and 5 am on the northern side of the Mine Street interchange in Redbank to move concrete barriers and traffic lights. Traffic control will be in place during these works.</p>
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Riverview

Brisbane Road	<p>Pedestrian access between Brisbane Road and Tessman Street will be closed during the day for approximately two weeks from Monday 30 May 2011 to facilitate the removal of trees and a retaining wall, and to realign the footpath closer to property boundaries. Pedestrians will be required to use Ipswich Street and Nile Street to access Tessman Street.</p>
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Ipswich Motorway	Works will be undertaken from Sunday 29 May 2011 for five nights between 8 pm and 5 am to construct a pier for the new Tessman Street pedestrian bridge in Riverview. Traffic on the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be reduced to one lane during these works.
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Dinmore

Cunningham Highway	<p>Works are continuing on upgrading the connections between the Ipswich Motorway, Warrego Highway and Cunningham Highway in Dinmore.</p> <p>Demolition works will be undertaken to remove the existing Cunningham Highway Bridge (eastbound) in Dinmore from 8 pm Friday 27 May 2011 and will continue through to 5 am Monday 30 May 2011. Motorists wishing to access Ipswich will be diverted via the Cunningham Highway to the Redbank Plains interchange, then via the Cunningham Highway to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore. See attached flyer for more details.</p> <p>Additionally, asphaltting works will be undertaken during the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pm Monday 30 May to 5 am Tuesday 31 May 2011 • 8 pm Tuesday 31 May to 5 am Wednesday 1 June 2011. <p>Ipswich bound motorists will be diverted as per above.</p>
Warrego Highway	<p>Work is continuing on the new Warrego Highway Bridge (eastbound) in Dinmore. Night works will be undertaken to lift the bridge beams onto the new bridge. For the safety of motorists and onsite workers, diversions are required via River Road, Dinmore. Motorists travelling from the Warrego Highway to the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) will be diverted at the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pm Friday 3 June to 5 am Saturday 4 June 2011 • 8 pm Saturday 4 June to 9 am Sunday 5 June 2011. <p>In case of wet weather or construction delays, a diversion may occur between 8 pm Sunday 5 June and 5 am Monday 6 June 2011.</p>

Ongoing work

Goodna

Church Street underpass	Works are continuing at the Church Street underpass, with one-way traffic access from Queen Street. A long-term diversion is in place via the Bertha Street underpass for traffic travelling from north to south across the motorway.
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Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	<p>Works are continuing to complete the new pedestrian bridge. The existing footpath along a section of Brisbane Road near the lift, has temporarily closed with pedestrian access diverted through the Queensland Rail car park. This diversion will be in place for approximately two months. Access to the pedestrian bridge will be maintained.</p> <p>Origin Alliance is working hard to ensure the lift is operational as soon as possible, but due to current high demand for the relevant parts, the lift is not expected to be operational until late June 2011.</p>
Brisbane Road	Works are continuing along the length of Brisbane Road from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp with the construction of retaining walls for the motorway upgrade. Works will be ongoing until late 2011.
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road	Finishing works on Smiths Road and Bellevue Road are continuing and will be complete by the end of June 2011.

Redbank

Mine Street	The section of Mine Street between Collingwood Drive and the interchange is expected to be completed in July 2011. Traffic will be reduced to one lane along Mine Street and delays are to be expected. Major works on the Mine Street interchange will be ongoing until late 2011.
Monash Road	Works are continuing on the Monash Road connection and will occur intermittently in this area until late 2011.

Riverview

Brisbane Road	Construction is underway on the section of service road between Tessman Street and Esther Street. Works will continue until approximately August 2011.
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Dinmore

Dossie Lane	Earthworks have commenced along Dossie Lane in preparation for the construction of the new retaining wall and eastbound lanes of the Warrego Highway. To enable these works, Dossie Lane has been closed to traffic and Dossie Street is now a cul-de-sac at the end that joins Dossie Lane. This arrangement will be in place until approximately September 2011.
Dinmore Park	<p>Works are continuing on the new bridge in Dinmore Park. For the duration of these works, pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station will be detoured around the park with temporary traffic management in place. These works will continue until approximately November 2011.</p> <p>Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park has temporarily changed to enable construction of the new pedestrian bridge across Brisbane Road in Dinmore. Entry into the car park will only be via the access on Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore. This change will remain in place until approximately August 2011.</p>



General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to relieve traffic congestion and improve safety and reliability for motorists. The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
