## New work

### Goodna

<p>Church Street off-ramp (Brisbane bound)</p>	<p>From the night of <b>Sunday 31 July 2011</b>, the Goodna exit from the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) at Church Street, will close for approximately six months. Brisbane bound motorists wishing to access Goodna from the motorway will need to use the following off-ramps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Redbank Exit at Mine Street – detour via Smiths Road to Goodna or</li> <li>• Logan Motorway exit at Gailes – detour via Brisbane Road to Goodna.</li> </ul> <p>This closure is necessary to facilitate construction of the permanent Brisbane bound motorway alignment. See the attached flyer for further information.</p>
<p>Church Street underpass</p>	<p>Demolition is continuing on the old Church Street bridge at Goodna to make way for construction of the new Brisbane bound section of the motorway. The bridge decks have been successfully removed and the sides of the bridge will be demolished on the nights of <b>Friday 22 July and Sunday 24 July 2011</b> (contingency only), <b>between 8 pm and 5 am</b>. Traffic control will be in place to safely direct motorists around the area.</p>

## Redbank

Mine Street off-ramp (Brisbane bound)	The extended Mine Street off-ramp (Brisbane bound) will open to traffic on the morning of <b>Friday 29 July 2011</b> . Works will be undertaken on <b>Thursday 28 July from 8 pm</b> to prepare the off-ramp for the switch. Traffic control will be in place to direct motorists during this work.
Mine Street (south side of motorway)	Works will be undertaken between <b>8 pm and 5 am each night from Sunday 24 July to Thursday 28 July 2011</b> to install conduits on the south side of the Mine Street interchange. Traffic control will be in place during this work.
Collingwood Drive (between Namatjira and Smiths Road intersections)	Works will be undertaken from <b>8 pm on Friday 29 July to 5 am Monday 1 August 2011</b> to complete the pavement between Namatjira Drive and Collingwood Drive. Motorists heading towards the Ipswich Motorway will be reduced to one lane during these works under traffic control.

## Riverview

Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound)	From <b>7 pm Saturday 23 July to 6 am Sunday 24 July 2011</b> , works will be undertaken to realign Brisbane bound traffic onto the new motorway lanes near Tessman Street, Riverview. Traffic control will be in place during this work.
Ipswich Motorway (both directions)	From <b>8 pm Thursday 28 July to 5 am Friday 29 July 2011</b> and from <b>8 pm Friday 29 July to 6 am Saturday 30 July 2011</b> , works will be undertaken to remove the next section of the old Tessman Street Bridge. Traffic control will be in place during this work.

## Dinmore

Brisbane Road	<p>Night works will be undertaken to install drainage on Brisbane Road in Dinmore from <b>Sunday 24 July to Thursday 28 July 2011 between 8 pm and 5 am</b>. These works require the closure of the Brisbane Road off-ramp from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound).</p> <p>Motorists wishing to access Ipswich will be diverted via the Cunningham Highway, Redbank Plains interchange, then via the Cunningham Highway to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore. Detour signage will be in place.</p>

Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	<p>A temporary diversion is in place for pedestrians through the Goodna Train Station carpark.</p> <p>Repairs to the lift are almost complete.</p>	<p>Pedestrian footpath diversion – late July 2011</p> <p>Lift operational – late July 2011</p>
Brisbane Road, Goodna	Brisbane Road reduced to one lane from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp.	Late 2011
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road, Goodna	Finishing works are nearing completion. Traffic conditions will change from time to time. Detours and traffic control will be in place.	Late July 2011

Where	What	Completed by
Mine Street, Redbank	The section of Mine Street between Smiths Road and north of the Mine Street interchange will at times be reduced to one lane in each direction.	Mine Street – End July 2011 Mine Street interchange major works – late 2011/early 2012
Brisbane Road, Riverview	Traffic control is in place to direct motorists and pedestrians accessing Brisbane Road between Duncan and Esther Streets.	End September 2011
Endeavour Road connection, Riverview	On occasion, traffic will be reduced to one lane under traffic control while bridge and service road works are underway.	September 2011
Dossie Lane, Dinmore	Dossie Lane is closed to traffic from both Dossie Street and Alfred Street for works on the Warrego Highway.	September 2011
Dinmore Park	Pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station is currently being detoured around the park. Entry to the Dinmore Train Station car park is currently via Brisbane Road with the exit only via River Road, Dinmore.	Dinmore Park – February 2012 Dinmore Train Station carpark – Late August 2011

### General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

### All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
