

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade - Wacol to Darra

Construction Update No 1

March – May 2008

The Queensland Government has appointed the SAFELink Alliance to design and construct the Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Wacol to Darra.

Construction of the upgrade is scheduled to begin in March 2008 with expected completion in late 2010.

Construction activities between March and May 2008 include:

- relocation of public utility services, including gas, electricity, telecommunications, water and sewer
- removal of trees and other vegetation
- installation of temporary concrete barriers and boundary fencing
- site establishment, including clearing of compounds and construction of temporary site offices
- bulk earthworks along both sides of the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- major drainage work at the Centenary Highway Interchange
- construction of bridges along the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway.

In addition to the above works, you may notice some changes along the Ipswich Motorway and Centenary Highway, such as increased construction vehicle movements and construction personnel around the Centenary Highway Interchange and removal and relocation of traffic signs.

During construction, every practical measure will be used to minimise any possible impact on motorists, the local community and the natural environment.

Work hours

Construction activities will occur between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday. Night works and weekend work may also be required and separate notifications will be provided prior to these works.
