

Ipswich Motorway Upgrade - Wacol to Darra

Construction Update No 3

October – December 2008

Construction works are continuing on section one (Jervis Street, Darra to Sandy Creek, Wacol) of the Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Wacol to Darra project with expected completion by December 2010.

Construction activities between October and December 2008 include:

- temporary closure of the Bullockhead Street off ramp from the Centenary Highway into Sumner (from 5 October to January 2009)
- bridge construction, including driven piling and movement of bridge beams along the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- bulk earthworks along both sides of the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- road pavement construction along the Centenary Highway and Ipswich Motorway
- construction of large retaining walls along the Centenary Highway and within the Centenary Highway Interchange
- minor realignments of the Ipswich Motorway and Centenary Highway to allow for widening works
- continued relocation of public utility services, including gas, electricity, telecommunications, water and sewer
- construction of a rail embankment and rail bridge as part of the Darra to Springfield Rail Transport Corridor
- start of construction for underpasses, pedestrian walkways and bike paths.

During construction, every effort is being made to minimise impacts on motorists, the local community and the natural environment.

Please remember that safety around road works is a two-way street. We ask that you drive carefully and responsibly during these construction works.
