## New work

### Goodna

Brisbane Road	Brisbane Road and the slow lane of the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) at Goodna, will be closed nightly between <b>8 pm and 4.30 am</b> from <b>Sunday 13 November until Thursday 17 November 2011</b> . These closures are necessary to paint the retaining wall along Brisbane Road. Detour signage and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists to use Mill Street. Access to and from the Queensland Rail car park will be maintained under traffic control.

### Redbank

Pan Pacific Peace Gardens	<p>From <b>mid November to mid December 2011</b>, access to and from the Pan Pacific Peace Gardens in McAuliffe Street, Redbank will temporarily change in order for the road connecting Francis Street and Railway Terrace to be completed.</p> <p>Motorists will be able to access the park by driving along the Francis Street eastbound motorway on-ramp, turning left into Railway Terrace and then right into McAuliffe Street. When leaving the park, motorists travelling to Brisbane will need to travel along McAuliffe Street and Railway Terrace and onto the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound). Motorists wishing to travel to Ipswich, will need to take the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound) and the Logan Motorway and Formation Street exit.</p>

## Dinmore

Brisbane Road	<p>Brisbane Road westbound will be closed between <b>8 pm and 5 am from Saturday 12 November to Tuesday 15 November 2011</b> to install large motorway signage and to facilitate pavement works.</p> <p>Traffic from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be diverted via the Cunningham Highway to the Redbank Plains interchange, then via the Cunningham Highway to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore. In case of weather or construction delays, works may occur on the night of Wednesday 16 November 2011.</p> <p>To implement a traffic switch, Brisbane Road eastbound will be closed to traffic between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Monday 14 November and Tuesday 15 November 2011</b>. Motorists will be diverted via River Road, Dinmore during these works. As a part of this switch, the Cunningham Highway eastbound will also be diverted via River Road <b>between 8 pm and 5 am on the night of Tuesday 15 November 2011</b>.</p>
Cunningham Highway	Works are continuing on upgrading the Cunningham Highway and Aberdare Street connection to the southern service road. Earthworks and asphalt works will be undertaken between <b>8 pm and 5am from Wednesday 16 November to Friday 18 November 2011</b> .
Ipswich Motorway	The installation of large motorway signage on the Ipswich Motorway will occur at night and require diversions of Ipswich bound and Cunningham Highway (westbound) motorists via River Road, Dinmore from between <b>8 pm and 5 am on Friday 11 November and Saturday 12 November 2011</b> .

## General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.
