New work

Goodna

William Street	The William Street on-ramp will temporarily close from 10 pm Saturday 7 May and 5 am Sunday 8 May 2011 to safely install bridge girders over the Ipswich Motorway at Goodna. Detours will be in place for Ipswich bound motorists via Smiths Road for entry to the motorway at the Mine Street on-ramp at Redbank.
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Dinmore

Brisbane Road on-ramp	<p>Night works are required to relocate concrete barriers and line mark the Brisbane Road on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound). These works require a diversion via River Road, Dinmore for the safety of motorists and onsite workers. The diversion will occur from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pm Sunday 8 May to 5 am Monday 9 May 2011. <p>In case of wet weather or construction delays, a diversion may occur from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pm Monday 9 May to 5 am Tuesday 10 May 2011. <p>Temporary traffic management will be in place for the duration of the diversion.</p>
Brisbane Road intersection	Pavement testing works will be undertaken in preparation for major intersection works. For the safety of motorists and onsite workers, these works will be undertaken at night and will occur from 8 pm Tuesday 10 May to 5 am Wednesday 11 May 2011.

Endeavour Road connection	From 7 am to 1 pm on Saturday 7 May 2011 , a concrete pour will be undertaken at the Endeavour Road connection in Riverview. Traffic control will be in place for the duration of these works.
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Ongoing work

Goodna

Church Street underpass	Works are continuing at the Church Street underpass, with one-way traffic access from Queen Street. A long-term diversion is in place via the Bertha Street underpass for traffic travelling from north to south across the motorway.
Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	Works are continuing to complete the new pedestrian bridge and are ongoing in the car park. As a part of these works, pedestrian access near the Queensland Rail car park at Goodna has temporarily changed. The existing footpath along a section of Brisbane Road, near the lift, has temporarily closed with pedestrian access diverted through the Queensland Rail car park. This diversion will be in place for approximately two months. Access to the pedestrian bridge will be maintained. Origin Alliance is working hard to ensure the lift is operational as soon as possible, but due to current high demand the relevant parts will not be available until late May 2011.
Brisbane Road	Works are continuing along the length of Brisbane Road from the BP service station to the Goodna westbound on-ramp with the construction of retaining walls for the motorway upgrade.
Smiths Road/Bellevue Road	Finishing works on Smiths Road and Bellevue Road are continuing and will be complete by June 2011.

Redbank

Mine Street underpass	To facilitate the removal of the Mine Street bridges, the Mine Street underpass will be closed in both directions to motorists, cyclists and pedestrians from 8 pm Saturday 7 May to 5 am Sunday 8 May 2011 . Motorists will be detoured via Smiths Road and Brisbane Terrace. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to the Law Street pedestrian bridge. Additionally, the underpass will be reduced to one lane in each direction during the following times: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pm Friday 6 May to 8 pm Saturday 7 May • 5 am Sunday 8 May to 5 am Monday 9 May 2011. Traffic control will be in place for the duration of the works.
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Monash Road	Works are continuing on the Monash Road connection and will occur intermittently in this area until late 2011.
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Riverview

Brisbane Road	<p>A small section of Brisbane Road (near Tessman Street) has been closed to motorists until early 2012. Vehicles are to detour to Ipswich Street. Pedestrian access has been maintained, however at times may be detoured to Ipswich Street.</p> <p>Construction is underway on the section of service road between Tessman Street and Esther Street. Works will be undertaken from 6.30 am to 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday and will continue until approximately August 2011. A construction site gate has been installed on Tessman Street and will be accessible at all times by residents and local traffic.</p>
Tessman Street overpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	Both the Tessman Street overpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp to the Ipswich Motorway at Riverview has permanently closed. Alternative routes are via Riverview Road to the Warrego Highway on-ramp or via Old Ipswich Road to the Francis Street on-ramp. The Endeavour Road connection is now open for motorists to access north and south Riverview.

Dinmore

Dossie Street	Dossie Lane has been closed to traffic and Dossie Street is now a cul-de-sac at the end that joins Dossie Lane. This arrangement will be in place until approximately June 2011.
Dinmore Park	Works are continuing on the new bridge in Dinmore Park. For the duration of these works, pedestrian access to the Dinmore Train Station will be detoured around the park with temporary traffic management in place. These works will continue until approximately November 2011.

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to relieve traffic congestion and improve safety and reliability for motorists. The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6.30 am and 6.30 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
