

Project Overview

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to relieve traffic congestion as well as improve safety and reliability for motorists.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by the Origin Alliance which comprises the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

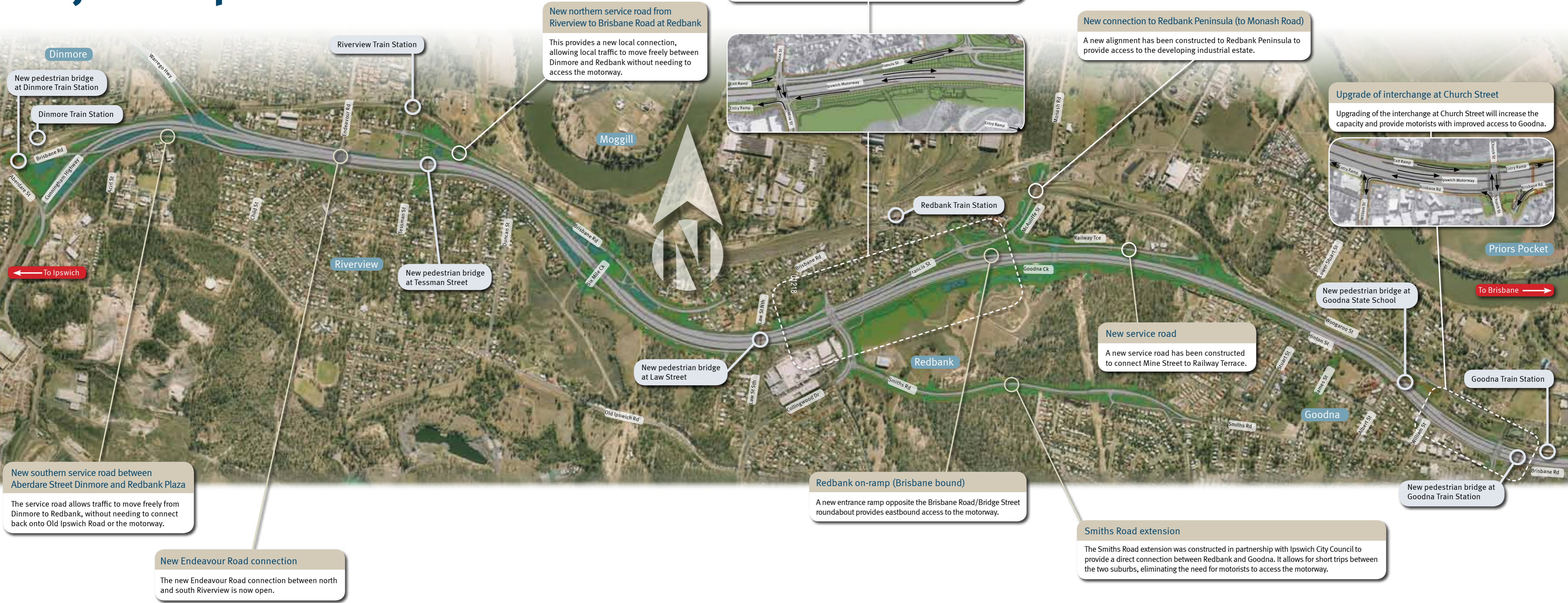
The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

When construction of the Dinmore to Goodna upgrade is completed in late 2012, key community benefits will include a more reliable traffic flow on the motorway, improved road safety, increased motorway capacity and an improved network of local roads.

The VEC

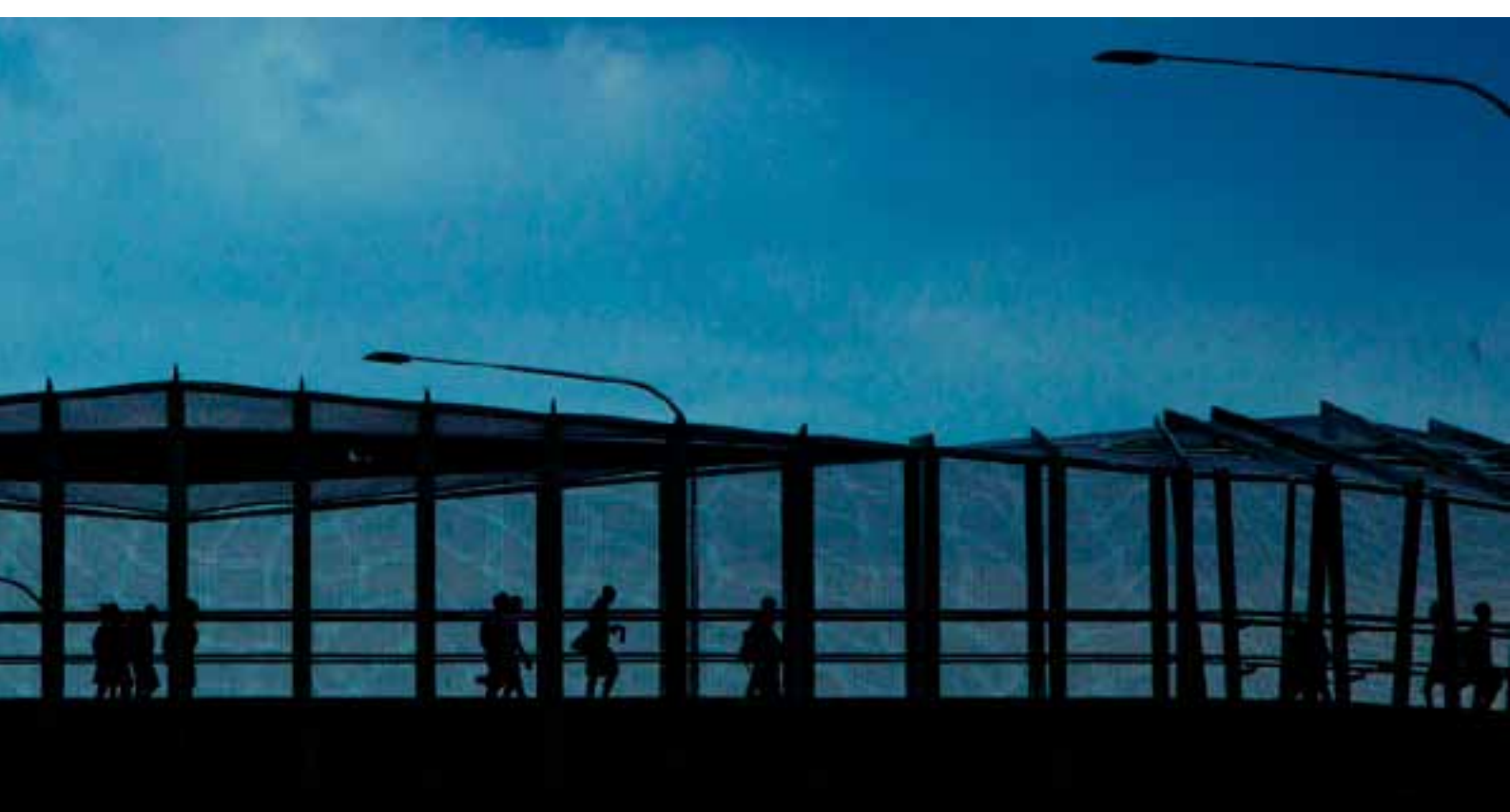
