New work

Goodna

Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge	The Goodna Train Station pedestrian bridge will be closed from 5 am Saturday 3 December until 6 pm Sunday 4 December 2011 to facilitate concrete works. Access to the train station will be via the Church Street or Bertha Street underpass. Assistance with access can be provided - please call 1800 465 682.
Church Street underpass and Brisbane bound on-ramp	The Church Street underpass and the Brisbane bound on-ramp at Goodna will be closed between 8 pm and 4.30 am from Sunday 4 December to Thursday 8 December 2011 . This closure is necessary to undertake bridge construction works. A detour and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.



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Redbank

Mine Street interchange and Francis Street	Works will be undertaken between 8 pm and 5 am from Sunday 4 December to Friday 9 December 2011 to asphalt, kerb and paint at the Mine Street interchange and along Francis Street. Traffic control will be in place for these works.
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Dinmore

Brisbane Road	<p>Brisbane Road westbound will be closed between 8 pm and 5 am on Sunday 4 December 2011 to relocate barriers. Traffic from the Ipswich Motorway (Ipswich bound) will be diverted via the Cunningham Highway to the Redbank Plains interchange, then via the Cunningham Highway to the Aberdare Street off-ramp in Dinmore.</p> <p>Night works are continuing on the installation of a conduit across Brisbane Road (west of Aberdare Street) in Dinmore. Works will be undertaken between 8 pm and 5 am from Wednesday 7 December to Friday 16 December 2011. Traffic control will be in place to guide motorists around works.</p>
Cunningham Highway	Night works are continuing on the Cunningham Highway (eastbound) with motorists to be diverted around works between 8 pm and 5 am from Sunday 4 December to Thursday 8 December 2011 . Motorists travelling to Brisbane will be diverted via the Aberdare Street off-ramp to the Brisbane Road on-ramp onto the Ipswich Motorway (Brisbane bound).

General information

The Australian Government has committed \$1.95 billion to upgrade the existing Ipswich Motorway between Dinmore and Goodna to improve traffic flow, safety and reliability for motorists. The upgrade includes the widening of the Ipswich Motorway to a minimum of six lanes and construction of new service roads to improve local access.

The Ipswich Motorway Upgrade: Dinmore to Goodna project is being delivered by Origin Alliance, comprising the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Abigroup Contractors, Fulton Hogan, Seymour Whyte Constructions, SMEC Australia and Parsons Brinckerhoff.

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Construction work will generally be carried out between the hours of 6 am and 6 pm, Monday to Saturday. Residents will be notified of any work undertaken outside these hours.

All works are subject to weather and construction conditions.
