Traffic changes at Sippy Creek Road, Tanawha

As part of the Bruce Highway Upgrade – Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway, a temporary connection road is being constructed from the culdesac at Parkyn Road to Cunning Road, Tanawha.

The temporary connection road will be open from early-November 2018, weather permitting, and be in place until mid-2020, maintaining access for local businesses and residents while work continues on Martin and Frizzo roads.

As a result, Martin Road will be temporarily closed while we build the new section between Martin Road and Sippy Creek Road.

In the week following these changes, the Frizzo Road northbound on ramp will be realigned to allow work to commence in that area. Please refer to the map overleaf for more information about the local traffic changes.

What to expect:

Changed traffic conditions for Sippy Creek Road, Tanawha:

- A new temporary road between Sippy Creek Road and Parkyn Road will provide local access to businesses and private properties.
- Motorists will access Sippy Creek Road via Wilson Road and Cunning Road, Tanawha.
- Motorists wanting to travel south will go via Sippy Downs interchange and take the southbound on ramp to the Sunshine Motorway.
- Motorists wanting to travel north will go via Wilson Road, Tanawha.
- Martin Road will be temporarily closed while we rebuild the section between Martin Road and Sippy Creek Road.

Increased construction activities:

- Residents can expect heavy vehicles and machinery to be used that cause increased dust and noise. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used during work hours.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation during these works.

Other construction activities nearby:

Day works (Mon-Sat, 6am-6pm):

- Ongoing major earthworks and drainage works near Tanawha Road, the Bruce Highway median (north of the Sunshine Motorway), the new western service road between Martin Road and Sippy Creek Road).
- Service relocation works for water, telecommunications and electricity.
- Pavement works near Sippy Creek Road and Parkyn Road.
- Temporary traffic management on local roads to facilitate works.
- Ongoing works in preparation to switch Bruce Highway northbound traffic (north of Sunshine Motorway) to the centre median.
- Vegetation removal activities.

Night works (Sun-Thurs, 7pm-5am):

- Service relocation works for water, telecommunications and electricity.
- Installation of precast bridge components and concrete pours at the Sunshine Motorway interchange.
- Ongoing drainage works near the Sunshine Motorway interchange to Sippy Downs.
- Temporary traffic management on local roads to facilitate works.
- Scheduled maintenance activities in various areas.
- Ongoing works in preparation to switch Bruce Highway northbound traffic (north of Sunshine Motorway) to the centre median.
- Vegetation removal activities.

Traffic changes at Sippy Creek Road to Cunning Road, Tanawha

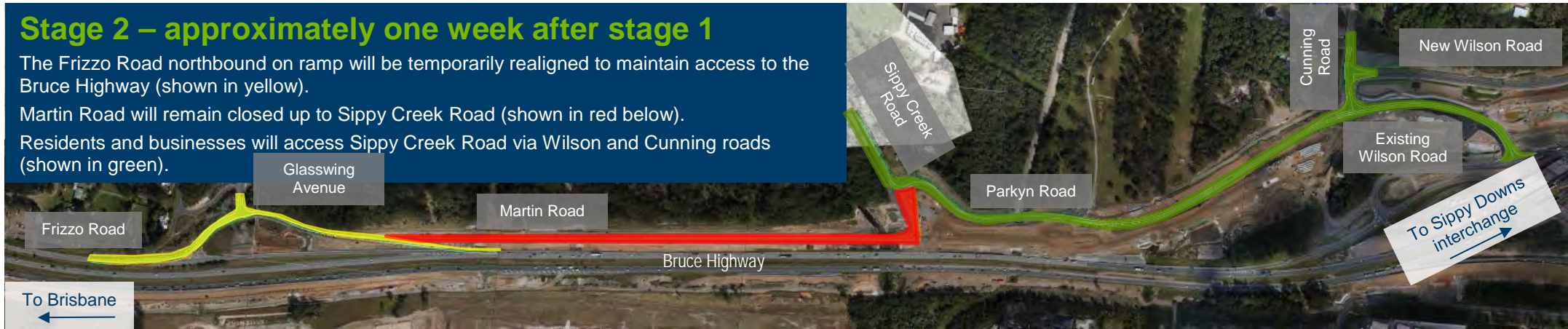
Stage 1 – from early-November 2018

Martin Road will be temporarily closed just north of Glasswing Avenue, up to Sippy Creek Road (shown in red). Residents and businesses will access Sippy Creek Road via Wilson and Cunning roads (shown in green). The Frizzo Road northbound on ramp will remain unchanged (shown in yellow).



Stage 2 – approximately one week after stage 1

The Frizzo Road northbound on ramp will be temporarily realigned to maintain access to the Bruce Highway (shown in yellow). Martin Road will remain closed up to Sippy Creek Road (shown in red below). Residents and businesses will access Sippy Creek Road via Wilson and Cunning roads (shown in green).



Final design

Temporary traffic changes are required to facilitate construction of the final design (see below). The new western service road will provide full access for businesses and residents on the western side of the Bruce Highway.
