Opening of the new Caloundra Road - Bruce Highway southbound on ramp

The Department of Transport and Main Roads would like to advise that the new southbound on ramp from Caloundra road to the Bruce Highway will be opening to traffic during night shift on Wednesday 5 December 2018, weather permitting.

This is the first permanent step in the total reconfiguration of Caloundra Road interchange as part of the Bruce Highway Upgrade – Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway.

The closure of the old ramp allows the project team to begin work in this area and continue construction for Australia's first Diverging Diamond Interchange.

The entrance to the new on ramp is approximately 200 metres east of the existing entrance. However, motorists will continue to merge onto the ramp from the left lane of Caloundra Road.

As well as the opening of the new on ramp, the Bruce Highway southbound lanes will be realigned to the east, allowing major construction activities including bridge, civil and utilities works to continue. These changes will remain in place until late 2019.
