

Bruce Highway Upgrade

Caloundra Road to Sunshine Motorway

Southern work zone

Closure of right turn lane to Bruce Highway southbound

The Department of Transport and Main Roads would like to advise that the existing right turn lane at the Caloundra Road interchange for motorists wishing to travel southbound onto the Bruce Highway from the direction of Steve Irwin Way will be permanently closed on Wednesday night 21 November 2018, weather permitting.

The closure of this access is required for safety reasons while construction continues on the total reconfiguration of the Caloundra Road interchange. Roadside barriers will be installed to safely separate motorists and roadworkers.

Motorists will still be able to access the Bruce Highway southbound on ramp by travelling east along Caloundra Road and using the Racecourse Road overpass or the

Roys Road interchange from Steve Irwin Way at Bells Creek. These will remain as the alternative routes until the opening of a new dedicated, free-flowing southbound entry ramp from the interchange to the highway in late 2019, weather permitting. Refer to map overleaf.
