

Gooding Drive roundabout (Nerang – Broadbeach Road) Upgrade

May 2017

About the works

Transport and Main Roads is delivering a \$160.7 million package of Gold Coast road transport infrastructure upgrades to cater for current and expected future traffic volumes. Delivery of these projects will also help ensure the road network is in good shape ahead of the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

As part of this package, work will soon start on improvements to the Gooding Drive roundabout and at the Palm Meadows Drive intersection.

The \$6.7 million construction contract has been awarded to Civil Mining & Construction Pty Ltd (CMC) and includes:

- an additional lane starting on the approach from Gooding Drive east, continuing through the roundabout and connecting to Gooding Drive west to reduce congestion
- a new free-flow slip lane from Gooding Drive west to Nerang–Broadbeach Road north to increase efficiency
- partial two-aspect (red and amber) traffic signals installed on the Gooding Drive east and Robina Parkway north approaches to improve safety
- new line-marking and directional signage to assist motorists in negotiating the roundabout safely
- extending footpaths and improving road crossings for pedestrian and cycling connections
- installing traffic signals at the Palm Meadows Drive intersection
- fencing and earthworks to facilitate the relocation of services.

What to expect

CMC will commence work on **Monday 22 May** and the project will continue until late 2017. The site compound will be established on the road reserve on the southern side of the Gooding Drive roundabout (Robina Parkway).

Standard work hours and days will be Monday to Saturday, 6am to 6pm, however it is expected that **some night works will be required** due to high traffic volumes at the roundabout.

During construction:

- Motorists can expect lane closures, reduced speed limits, increased congestion and construction vehicles entering and exiting from site compound. Drive to conditions, allow extra travel time and choose alternative routes if possible.
- Residents near to the work zone may experience increased noise, dust and vibration, however every effort will be made to minimise construction impacts.
- Public transport users – eastbound and westbound bus stops near Palm Meadows Drive will impacted during these works. Visit www.translink.com.au for details.
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours and changed paths may be required at times during construction. Be vigilant and keep personal safety top of mind.

It is important to note that this work schedule depends on weather, site and contractor conditions and may change without notice.
