

Gooding Drive Roundabout Upgrade (Nerang – Broadbeach Road) TEMPORARY ROUNDABOUT CLOSURE

July 2017

About the project

The Queensland Government is investing \$6.7 million to upgrade the Gooding Drive roundabout at Nerang – Broadbeach Road.

The contractor, CMC, has started construction to improve the Gooding Drive roundabout and Palm Meadows Drive intersection.

What to expect

On Monday 10 July, the western approach and exit to the Gooding Drive roundabout from Gooding Drive will temporarily close for up to 15 minutes between 10am-2pm.

This temporary closure is required to facilitate important Energex relocation works as part of the roundabout upgrade.

Traffic controllers will stop the traffic flow at the roundabout while workers conduct the activity.

Please plan your trip accordingly around these works and choose alternative routes, if possible.

Traffic changes and delays

A number of roundabout movements will be affected (see map overleaf).

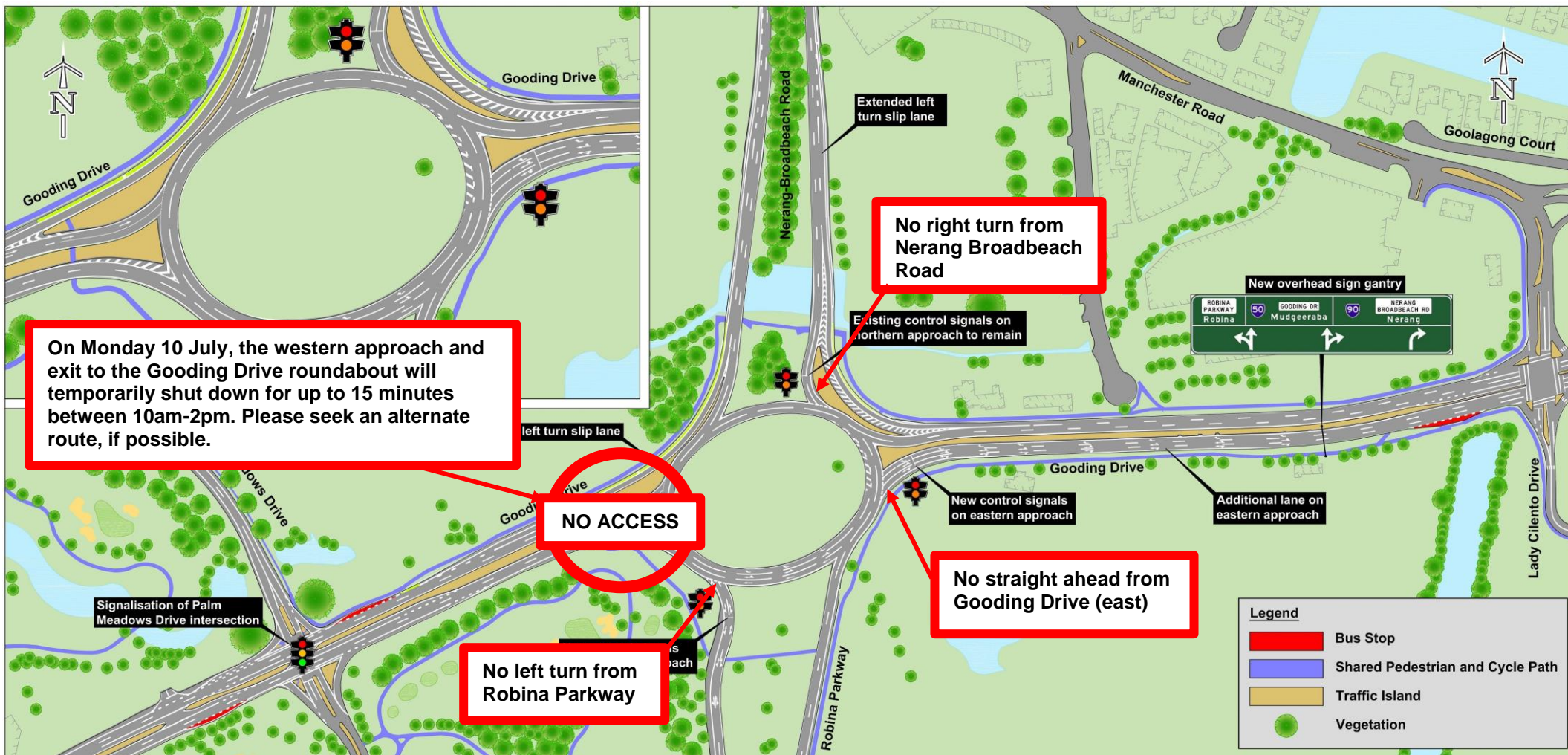
1. No access onto the roundabout from the western approach of Gooding Drive
2. No right turn exit from Nerang Broadbeach Road
3. No straight ahead exit from Gooding Drive eastern approach
4. No left turn exit from Robina Parkway

Delays of up to 15 minutes are predicted.
