Gooding Drive Roundabout Upgrade (Nerang – Broadbeach Road) ON-ROAD CYCLE LANE CLOSURES

August to November 2017

About the project

The Queensland Government is investing \$6.7 million to upgrade the Gooding Drive roundabout at Nerang – Broadbeach Road.

Contractor, CMC, has started construction to improve both the Gooding Drive roundabout and Palm Meadows Drive intersection.

What to expect

From early August for approximately four months, the designated on-road cycle lanes on Nerang-Broadbeach Road located near the exit and approach to the Gooding Drive roundabout will temporarily close to facilitate construction (see map overleaf).

Please take care when cycling through this section, or seek alternative routes during this time. All shared paths remain in operation.

Once complete, the upgrade will improve safety and connectivity for cyclists travelling through the roundabout with increased lane widths and better connections.

Activities on the Nerang-Broadbeach Road section will include:

- Line marking and lane realignments
- Earthworks
- Guard rail removal
- Pavement construction
- Barrier construction

Construction will involve:

- Speed limits will be reduced to 40km/h or 60km/h dependent on the level of activity and location of the construction zone
- The use of sizeable plant, machinery and vehicles
- Cycle to conditions, allow extra travel time and choose alternative routes, if possible.

The project team is committed to keeping the local cycling community informed about works.
