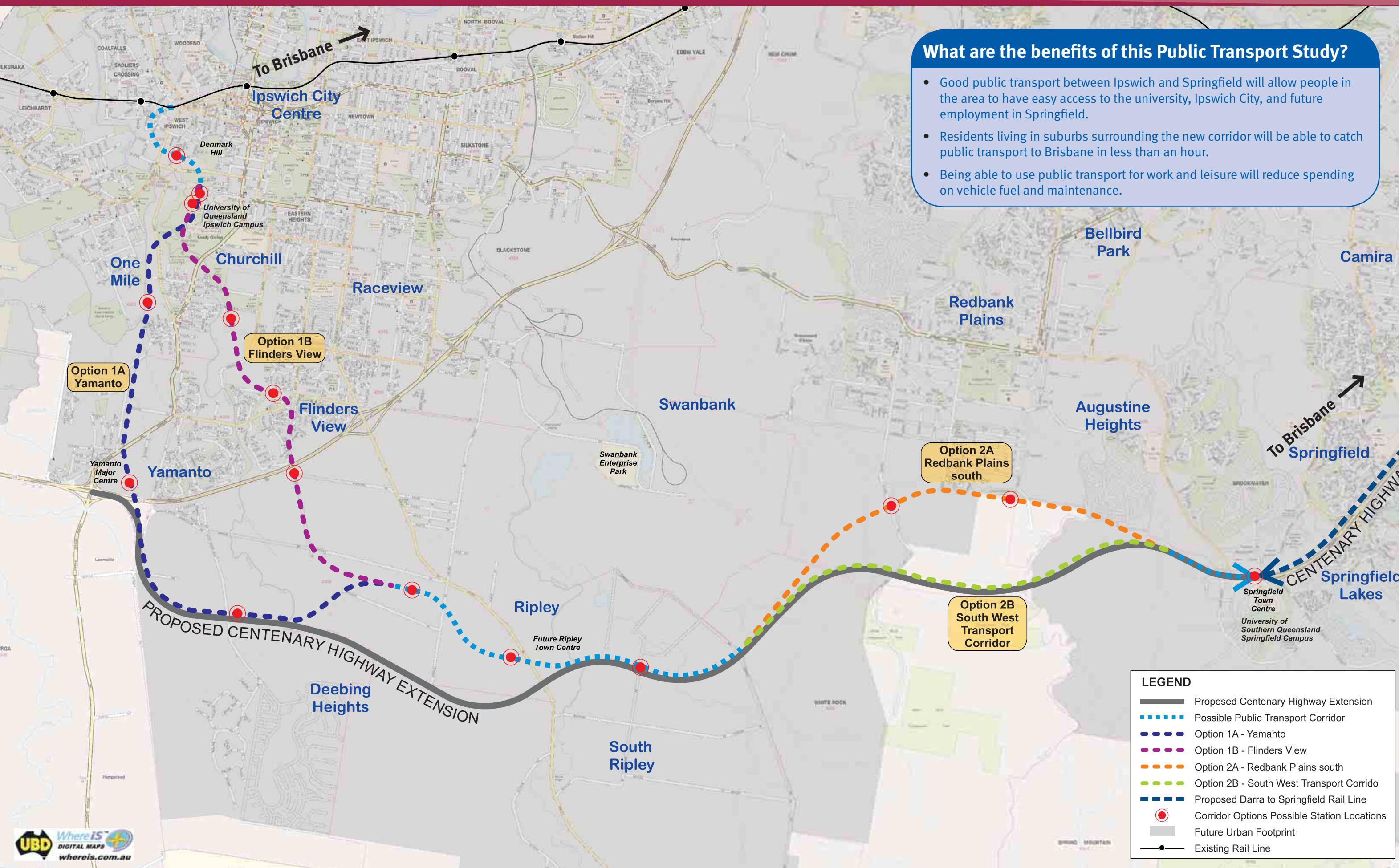


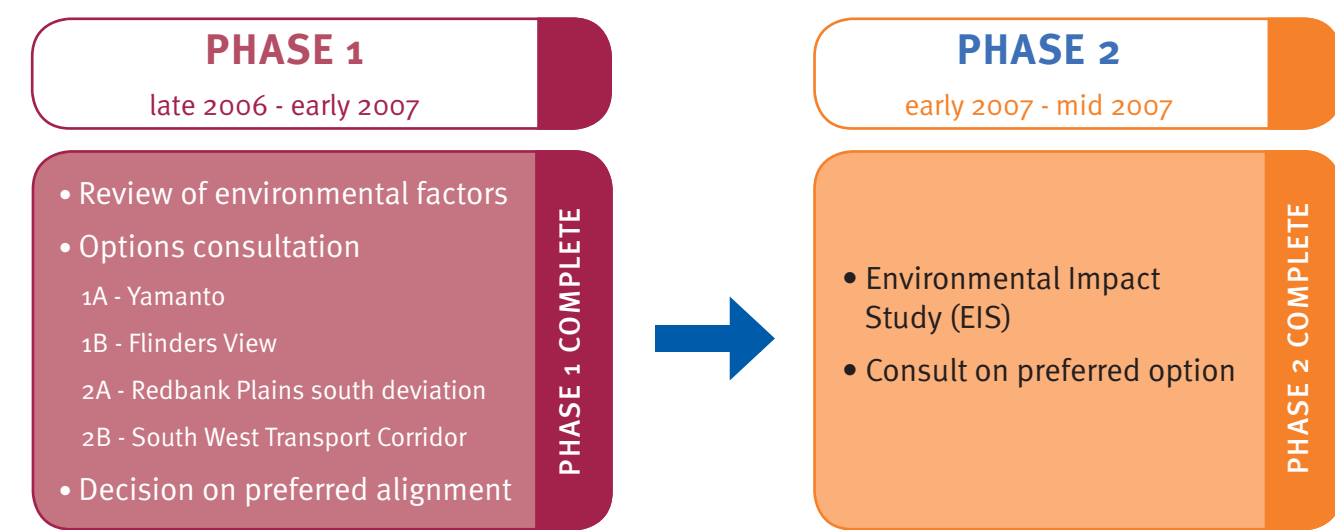
Ipswich to Springfield Public Transport Corridor Study
